Subject: Important Updates and Announcements for the New Year

I trust you had a wonderful holiday season.

As we begin the new year, I am pleased to inform you of the outcomes of our recent meeting and shoot. During the meeting, we successfully finalized the shoot schedule, which includes Massanutten hosting the State Closed event. The chosen format comprises a 28-field round on Saturday and a 14-hunter-14-animal round on Sunday. Additionally, Prince William will be hosting the Open, featuring the international round on both days. Sherwood will be hosting the Spring 3D, while BOR will take charge of the Fall 3D.

We encourage your active participation and support for these clubs, recognizing the significant effort involved in organizing such shoots. The indoor events will be organized by Two Rivers, BOR, Belvoir, and Sherwood, offering participants the flexibility to shoot one or two times and count the high score. This year, the clubs have scheduled a total of 93 shoots.

Save the date for our upcoming Banquet on March 23rd at the American Vets in Harrisonburg. The evening promises a delightful dinner, numerous raffles, door prizes, and the presentation of Hunting and Tournament awards. A distinguished guest speaker will also be in attendance. We encourage you to attend, reconnect with old friends, and forge new connections.

Our Indoor league, which commenced on January 1st, is still open for participation. There is no charge to shoot, and you have the opportunity to win a coveted belt buckle. League scores can be submitted for consideration. Looking ahead, we are planning an outdoor league in the spring with similar rules for winning a belt buckle.

On January 13th, we successfully conducted a Lancaster-type shoot at three different locations, attracting 32 participants, with 16 competing for cash prizes. Winners shared the prize money in their respective divisions.

I would like to inform you that VBA and NFAA are actively working on affiliation matters. NFAA has a 90day review period to evaluate all aspects, and we anticipate receiving feedback on any necessary changes. Just a friendly reminder to submit your club and membership paperwork to the secretary.

From the Hunting Vice President

Hope everyone had (or is still having) a great deer season! For 2024, the Hunting Committee has decided that the VBA priorities in support of bowhunters in VA will be:


"Contiguous season/harvest rules" for Bowhunters, which would allow those of us choosing to hunt exclusively with archery equipment to harvest deer of either sex throughout the archery, muzzleloader, and firearms season. No change to the bag limit, and archers would still comply with blaze orange requirements.

Ensuring archery begins before firearms season. There are several areas in VA where this is not true: Chesapeake/ Suffolk/VA Beach for example.

Increase bowhunting opportunities: In high density deer counties, VA DWR has increased firearms seasons. In these areas, VBA would like to see increased bowhunting opportunities by opening the archery season earlier, as well as allowing antlered deer harvest. Again, VBA thinks this increased opportunity would likely recruit more bowhunters, increase Archery License sales, and provide VA DWR additional population control options.

Spring Bear Hunting Season – not our top priority, but VBA would like to explore the concept with DWR

We will be working with DWR members and the DWR Board and will NEED YOUR HELP with these issues. We will likely ask you to email and/or call DWR and DWR Board members to help get the above initiatives put in place in support of VA bowhunters.

This agenda item proposes to:

- 1. Eliminate the Conservation Fund
- 2. Enhance the Scholarships provided by VBA

Background/Discussion:

At the January 2024 meeting, it was discussed that now that VBA finances are in better

condition, VBA should consider giving more and larger scholarships. Consider that adjusting for inflation from 1970, the \$500 scholarship outlined in the current Constitution is worth nearly \$4,000! As part of that discussion, concern was raised that the Constitution states Scholarships will come from the Conservation Fund, which severely limits VBAs flexibility and funding

available for Scholarships. One way to overcome this would be to eliminate the Conservation Fund and allow Scholarships to come out of the General Fund. The Board of Directors would 100% control the dollar value and how many scholarships VBA would award annually, to

include not awarding any scholarships if funding was not available. Part of the discussion was that VBA has and seeks funding in order to hold quality events, recognize our members, and

support our Clubs. Scholarships are another way to support VBA members and their families, and to answer the question "What has VBA done for me lately".

The Constitution mentions the Conservation Fund in three areas: Article 15, Section 15.1.10, Article 18, and Article 22, Standing Rule 7. Changes to each of these areas is outlined in the attached comparison:

An annual scholarship of \$500 is established to be paid from the Conservation Fund (provided sufficient funds are available) VBA members and their immediate family members are eligible. Scholarship can be used at any accredited institute of higher learning to be supporting archery, in general, conservation and bowhunting. Written request must be submitted to the VBA President by March 1st for approval by the Directors.	VBA desires to grant up to \$3,000 of scholarships annually to be paid from the General Fund. Each year, the Board of Directors will decide the amount and number of scholarships based on funding available and the desires of the Board. For example, VBA could award no scholarships is scholarships for \$500 each, or one for \$3,000, or any combination so desired. VBA members and their immediate family members (parents, siblings, spouse, or children) are eligible. The grandchildren of members are also eligible, but selection preference will be given to immediate family members. For example, if there are three scholarships available and three immediate family members. For example, if there are three scholarships available and three immediate family members. Scholarships may be used at any accredited institute of higher learning for any course of study; however, selection preference will be given to applicants purpung wildlife management, conservation, and related areas. Selection preference will also be given to those students who actively support archery and/or bowhurting and encourage others to do so. Requests must be submitted in writing to the President by March 1 st for approval by the Board and should outline academic achievements, leadership skill and ability, archery and/or bowhunting involvement, and other estracurricular activities.





The VBA Order of the Golden Feather was created to honor those persons who have given unselfishly of their time and talents toward the betterment of archery and archers. Recipients are persons who possess the virtues of sportsmanship, character, morals, integrity and friendship. As a reflection of the substance for membership, only 86 people have been elected to the Order in the past 78 years.

To be qualified, a candidate must be member in good standing of the VBA at the time of nomination, must have a minimum of ten successive years' membership in the VBA and must be sponsored by three VBA members of good standing or by a VBA Club.

This article is a reminder that candidates must be submitted to the Board of Directors at the March meeting for this year. Nominations must be in writing and be signed by sponsoring individuals or a Club officer. Successful nominees have always performed duties or had an impact outside their immediate club.
