From the Publicity Director

HAPPY NEW YEAR EVERYONE! As we conclude the bowhunting season, don't forget to send your applications for VBA Game Awards to Marie Bell no later than March 1st. The application and details are in the Fall and Winter issues of FLIGHT and on the VBA website. Please plan to attend our Twelfth Annual Awards Banquet that will be held on Saturday, March 24th at Pano's Restaurant in Harrisonburg with the social hour beginning at 5:30 p.m. There will be door prizes, silent auctions, and a guest speaker. We will recognize our Double Crown winners (Karin Eppard, Cay McManus, and David and Matthew Dobbins), and our Triple Crown winners (Lucas Kenley, Cay McManus, David and Matthew Dobbins). We will also be recognizing our Big Game and Double Slam winners, our Bill Bennett folks, and most importantly, our Order of the Golden Feather honoree. Tickets are available through your club president or by calling Kevin Reedy at 276-728-4456. Congratulations to all of you!

VBA 2007 CALENDAR OF EVENTS: Many of the state tournaments will be held in the northern part of Virginia this year. Belvoir Bowhunters and Sherwood Archers will once again be hosting the State Indoors Sectional on February 24th and 25th. Manahoac Bowmen will be hosting the Spring 3-D Classic (marked) on April 21st and 22nd, followed by the State Open hosted by Sherwood Archers on May 26th and 27th. As we wrap up the tournament season, Belvoir Bowhunters will be hosting the Fall 3-D Classic (unmarked) on August 18th and 19th, and Two Rivers Archers will be hosting the State Closed on September 1st and 2nd. I hope everyone will show their support and especially enjoy shooting on two ranges that have never held a state tournament.

The VBA: We continue to ask your support in soliciting members into the VBA. Why? The VBA is a state organization formed to promote archery and bowhunting in Virginia. It is an organization that helps protect your hunting rights, stands up against the anti-hunters, attends VDGIF meetings regarding issues that are important to us, the bowhunters; attends classes that are offered to our IBEP instructors and works with them in other hunting related projects. We have qualified instructors that conduct bowhunting and archery education classes. We are involved in the conservation and the preservation of our natural resources and wildlife, and attend many events to let folks know who we are, about the clubs, club and tournament shoots, and much more.

VBA EVENTS: In November (with many thanks to Joyce and Maxie Cameron from Two Rivers and Terry Ballowe from Shenandoah County Archers) we attended the grand opening of Gander Mountain in Winchester, along with representatives of other organizations such as Hunters for the Hungry, Ducks Unlimited, and Women in the Outdoors sponsored by the National Wild Turkey Federation. In January I will be representing the VBA at an annual event that is hosted by Heritage Baptist Church in Woodbridge where there will be exhibitors from various sporting organizations. Activities will include an archery and shooting competition and a wild game supper. In February, the Fredericksburg Expo Center and the Rockingham County Fairgrounds will be hosting outdoor shows, and we plan to be there too! Folks, this is why we need your club brochures for the VBA packets that we hand out at these events. Also, let me know if you know of other events that we can participate in.

VDGIF NEWS: J. Carlton Courter, III was named the new Director for the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, effective November 1, 2006. Mr. Courter formerly served as Commissioner of the Virginia Department of Agriculture. He was a member of the Agribusiness Council for 13 years and received the Distinguished Service Award and earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Virginia Tech in 1979. He was raised in Amelia County, and he and his family now reside in Midlothian. Over the years, he has served in leadership roles in state and local associations. The VDGIF has started the National Archery in Schools Program (NASP), which began in Kentucky in 2002. As of spring, 2006, 31 states have implemented this program, and 50 schools in Virginia are currently participating. The VDGIF hopes to have 100 schools in the program by August 2007. Hopefully, this program will lead many of these young people to join the VBA.

HUNTERS FOR THE HUNGRY NEWS: In order to reach their 2006 goal, this organization needs help from both hunters and non-hunters. In addition to deer, monetary gifts in any amount are appreciated to help fund proper preparation of the meat for distribution to the poor. This all-important support comes from folks like you. DIRECTIONS: Exit U.S. Route 1 (Richmond Highway) at traffic signal at Pohick Road. This intersection is the entrance to Fort Belvoir at Tulley Gate. Drive to the security control point and visitor center. Obtain a temporary vehicle pass at the visitor center adjacent to the control point by presenting driver's license and vehicle registration. Proceed south on Pohick Road to the first traffic light at Theote Road and turn right. Proceed approximately one-half mile to a stop sign at Warren Road and turn right. Proceed to Tompkins Basin, turning right at the intersection at the bottom of the hill. The new Indoor Range is the long white building (Bldg 778) on the right and set back from the road at the base of the hill. The new Fort Belvoir Archery Center is located in the same building.

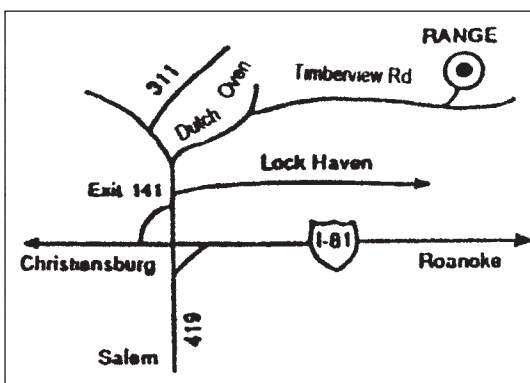

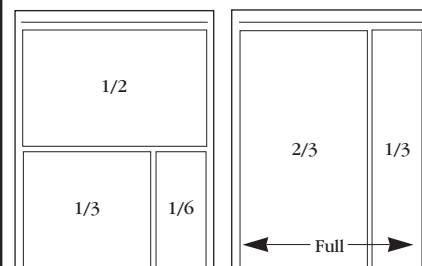
