
Lucas Kenley, CMFS; Kristofer Black, CMTRAD and Larrie Emerson, SMBB. Congratulations to all of you!





Drive to the security control point and visitor center. Obtain a temporary vehicle pass at the visitor center adjacent to the control point by presenting driver's license and vehicle registration. Proceed south on Pohick Road to the first traffic light at Theote Road and turn right. Proceed approximately one-half mile to a stop sign at Warren Road and turn right, Proceed to Tompkins Basin, turning right at the intersection at the bottom of the hill. The new Indoor Range is the long white building (Bldg 778) on the right and set back from the road at the base of the hill. The new Fort Belvoir Archery Center is located in the same building.

## FRUITED VENISON ROAST

Slow Cooker – 8 hr

Small venison roast Dried mixed fruit, chopped Raisins Craisins 1/4 C peach preserves 1/4 C red wine Spice Mixture: 2 TBS cinnamon 2 TBS cloves 1 tsp mace 2 TBS oil Salt & Pepper to taste

Butterfly a small roast. Spread with a layer of chopped mixed fruit, raisins and craisins. Sprinkle ½ of spice mixture over fruit. Roll up and secure with skewers or twine. Brown in oil. Sprinkle with salt and pepper and remaining spice mixture. Smother in peach preserves and pour red wine around base of roast. Cook in slow cooker on low for 8 hrs.
