



FOR WARWICK BOWMEN NEW RANGE

The Warwick Bowmen will officially open their new range in the Newport News City Park with a VBA sanctioned pin shoot on March 16th. To reach the new range, leave Interstate 64 at the Fort Eustis exit, turn west on Highway 143 and follow the signs to the campground. The range, by opening date, will contain a spacious practice area, picnic grounds and the first of three 28 target field courses. It is on beautifully wooded land populated by deer and other wildlife, in sight of a lake full of fish, and adjacent to the new campground.

The new range is a joint venture by the Warwick Bowmen and the City of Newport News. The city allocated the land as an integral part of the total park system. Access is controlled by the park rangers based on rules agreed upon by the club and city officials. The arrangement gives the Warwick Bowmen a voice in the management of the facility yet insures that its maintenance and operation will be in conformance with that of the rest of the park system. The project has progressed so successfully it promises to become an outstanding example of what can be accomplished through such a cooperative effort. The exchange of ideas, joint contributions of both financing and labor, and the joint management using the club "archery know-how" and the full time supervision of the park service should provide, in the near future, one of the finest archery facilities in the state.

For the 1968 season, Harold announced that Lee Wooster, Northern Virginia Archers, wins the Big Carp Trophy with a 36-pounder. Murray Selby, also of NORVA, reported second and third largest carp.

New membership forms reflecting NFAA dues changes are available and must be used instead of the obsolete ones.

NFAA is proposing to purchase Archery Magazine. Roy Hoff would be employed as Editor, with NFAA assuming all responsibility for the magazine.

Bill now has deputies in all zones. He requested that all clubs get in touch with their deputies promptly upon receipt of range inspection notices or whenever they need special inspections. Any notices regarding inspections received from NFAA should be sent to the zone deputy.

The Championship tournament is scheduled for ^{March 4 & 5} ~~April 17th and 18th~~, and will be held at the *James Madison High School in Vienna, Va., located in the heart of Fairfax County. In order to qualify to shoot, an archer must have at least ~~seven~~ ^{seven} PAA round indoor tournament scores officially recorded and certified by respective club secretaries. This tournament will be ^{basically} ~~basically~~ a team competition of four members with standard handicap. Competing ~~teams~~ ^{AND IND AND IND} will shoot one PAA round each day (total, two) to determine winners. Entries will be by ~~team only~~ ^{AND IND} with advance registration cost for each team of

All participants are advised to wear tennis or bowling shoes as tournament will be conducted in the school gymnasium. NOTE: Send in your pre-registration forms now. VBA executive committee recommendations will be followed.
