## Virginia Bowhunter Association State Closed Championships

The Virginia Bowhunter Association State Closed Championships were held Sept. 3, 4 at the Newport News City Park hosted by the Warwick Bowmen, with 153 tournament shooters from across Virginia.

Michael Lewis, 16, shot a 1103 out of a possible 1120 to become the VBA State Closed Freestyle Unlimited Champion. Ronnie Lewis, Michael's father, won the VBA State Closed Freestyle Limited Championship. This is the first time a father-son combination has taken side by side Championships in VBA history. The Lewis's reside in Fredericksburg, Va.

Cay McManus, the longest running, undefeated female State Champion, won the 1988 VBA State Closed Barebow Championship. She also outshot the men in the male Barebow Division. Cay had just returned from Darrington, Washington, where she won both the World Field Championships and the National Field Championships. The only woman in VBA history to hold every major Championship title field archery has to offer.



The bonus point sheet and indoor range inspection sheet (if applicable) are the only portions to be filled out by the range inspector. If you have not received forms at least thirty (30) days prior to your inspection date contact the field governor.

Under the N.F.A.A. Constitution and By-laws, page 98, Article XVII, Section B, Item 4 "The NFAA director or his delegate shall be paid 21¢ per mile by a club or association for travel incurred to inspect their course." The V.B.A. does not cover this cost so the responsibility falls on the club.




