### In Loving Memory Of... \_

On Friday, June 19, 1987 the Virginia Bowhunters and archery in general lost a valued member of our association.

Mertie Edith Shultz died at the age of 79 peacefully and with dignity in her sleep at home after fighting a courageous bout with cancer. Mertie's passing leaves a never to be filled void in the lives of all who knew and loved her.

She had been a member of VBA, the NFAA and Two Rivers Archery Club in Front Royal for over 25 years. In 1976, Mertie became a member of the Order of the Golden Feather and was very active in various local clubs and organizations in her hometown.

One of Mertie's greatest loves, I believe, was the opportunity that she had for many years working with hundreds of school children and with the Northern Va. 4-H clubs, teaching them archery and also her involvement with the Camp Fantastic program. Camp

Fantastic is, of course, a week long event held each summer for young people suffering from cancer and Mertie and her beloved husband, Dutch, gave unselfishfully of their time and taught archery each year to these "special" kids. It is indeed ironic that she should succumb to cancer herself.

Mertie was born August 8, 1907. She is survived by her husband, Horace; a son, Curtiss, 2 grandsons and 6 greatgrandchildren. Had Mertie lived until June 21st, she and Dutch would have celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary. A memorial service was held instead that day and her burial was at a later

date in Sunbury, Penn.
Even though Mertie is gone, she will always live in the hearts and minds of all who loved her.

Let us remember Dutch and the Shultz family in our prayers and be comforted in knowing that Mertie has passed on to




### Norva's Annual Deerslayer September 12, 13






