V.B.A. FILES COMPLAINT

The following letter was written to the Va. Game Commission by VBA Hunting Vice-President Dave Proctor regarding early black powder season at the same time as early archery season. Dave wrote this letter to the commission on direction of VBA delegates at the March VBA meeting.

April 1, 1981

Dear Sir:

The Virginia Bowhunters Association is very much opposed to a black powder hunting season during the early archery season.

the early archery season.
We feel that it would present a hazardous safety situation to the archer. A camo-bowhunter sharing the woods with a gunhunter is a safety problem that should be seriously considered.

An early black powder season would also increase the number of gunhunters and decrease the number of bowhunters. At least 50% of the present bowhunters are also gunhunters; and, if given the choice, they will probably choose the black powder rifle which is a more successful way of hunting.

This early black powder season would also give Virginia an earlier gun season than any of the bordering states, and would invite hunters from surrounding states to flood into our state for an early hunting season. This would add more hunting pressure for both the hunter and the game commission to contend with.

These are some of our concerns as bowhunters and we ask that you consider them before making a decision to alter the hunting season.


