Schedule session will be held at 4 o'clock, September 21, 3rd quarter range inspections must be completed in order to receive shoots. A club delegate must be at the meeting or a zone spokesman in order to receive 4 dates.

A maximum of 3 association shoots and one (1) special invitational shoot are allowed. Only one special trophy shoot is allowed a club.

As of this date registration fees for association shoots are \$1.50 per individual.

Indoor schedules will be set for any clubs desiring dates. With a possible indoor championship tournament in 69, we hope our indoor program will become very active.

There seems to be some problem as to scheduling of annuals on consecutive weekends in some zones. If possible this should be worked out within the zone.

Please note the price increase of V.B.A. pins from 90¢ to \$1.10 Effective 15 July.

Remember the 90 day rule in effect for the state shoot.

22ND ANNUAL VBA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT SEPT. 1 and 2, 1968 AUGUSTA ARCHERS RANGE, STAUNTON, VA.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRE-REG-ISTRARS: You Must turn in your classification card and pick up your registration number during the hours of registration on Saturday evening, August 31, or Sunday morning, September 1. Time of registering is listed in program in this Flight.

The Augusta Archers range is located off of U.S. Rt. 250 (2.6 miles east of Staunton city limit sign and 6.7 miles west of Waynesboro city limit sign), turn off at M&M Restaurant. Watch for target sign.

The Augusta Archers will have three 28-target ranges this year. Saturday afternoon, starting at 2:00 p.m., there will be a tournament on this range with awards. There will be casual registration—as soon as four have registered, that group will start on Target No. 1.


