From the President

I would like to publicly thank two of our VBA Clubs and their members for noteworthy contributions to the VBA.

First I would like to think the Members of Northern Virginia Archers (NORVA) for their hosting of the 2016 VBA State Open held 28 and 29 May at their range in Fairfax County, Virginia. Any club that has hosted a State level tournament knows the tremendous amount of preparation and work it takes to get their range ready and host other Archers from around the State. The NORVA range was immaculate, and fully justified the pride the NORVA members have in it. The weather was beautiful both days – lots of sunshine but not too hot! I must admit that one of my favorite things was the food. I don't know where they found him, but NORVA had a cook preparing food that was so good (especially those slabs of ribs), it was worth the trip even if you didn't have a great shooting day on the range! For those that couldn't make it, you really missed a great event, and a chance to meet lots of great folks who love archery as much as you do!

While I'm on the topic, I want to talk just a moment about shooting field targets. I'm a Bowhunter, and I certainly love shooting life like 3D targets. But more often than not, you will find me on the field target side of a range when I practice. Let me explain why. As I point out to the students in my IBEP classes, it takes two things to be a successful Bowhunter: 1) Opportunity, and 2) Execution. Opportunity is all about being a good hunter. Getting to really know and understand the game you hunt, until you can consistently find and get within bow range. Until you have that skill set, it won't matter how good a shot you are with your bow. But the other skill – being able to execute the shot when the opportunity presents – is just as important to success. I'm sure all of us know fellow Bowhunters who see trophy animals, but just can't close the deal. That's where shooting field targets comes in. Field targets are set up at known distances on cleared lanes; so there are no excuses. If you can't consistently put arrows where you aim them under these conditions, what makes you think you can hit where you aim on a moving animal in the woods from an elevated treestand? Shooting field targets is all about execution of the shot. It helps you develop technique and muscle memory so it becomes automatic, and that pays off in the woods!

My second "Thank You" goes to the Members of the Bowhunters of Rockingham (BOR). I have mentioned to your Delegates several times that I am absolutely committed to not raising VBA annual dues. Instead, we are constantly looking for ways to get the work of the VBA done that reduces our overhead. One large expense we have is paying for the meeting rooms used to conduct our quarterly meeting with the Delegates, and recently the hotel where we meet was sold, and we were told the price would be going up. In stepped the BOR with a most gracious offer to allow us to conduct our next four meetings at their indoor range. This will allow us to save a substantial amount over the next year. I know it is an inconvenience for some of the members of the BOR who might otherwise use their indoor range for shooting (especially in the winter), and I am most appreciative of their generous offer. AGENDA ITEMS

AGENDA ITEM VOTED AT JUNE MEETING:

(7) Article 15 Tournaments, Sect.15.1.2., Spring 3-D Classic, B. Change to read: The Spring 3-D will be a 2 day shoot. The 3-D will have marked distance. There will be a minimum of 25 targets. Maximum distance will be 60 yards. Archers have the option of shooting 1 or 2 days and counting highest score. Effective, 2017. Passed, unanimously.

AGENDA ITEM FOR SEPTEMBER MEETING:

(1) VBA Bylaws, Art. 14.3-D Styles of Shooting, pg. 10 of 23: Amend as follows: Delete: "Refer to IBO Shooting Rules." Insert: "Use VBA Classifications and Shooting Styles for the VBA Spring Classic and Fall Classic 3-D tournaments and use VBA 3-D rules.: effective: January 1, 2018, as amended.

Justification: Avoid confusion for Host Clubs and Shooters as to IBO vs.VBA rules, classifications, and shooting styles. At the Spring Classic, a great majority of shooters were familiar with VBA classifications, but not IBO. Shooters that claimed to know IBO classifications, often gave wrong information and had to be reclassified.

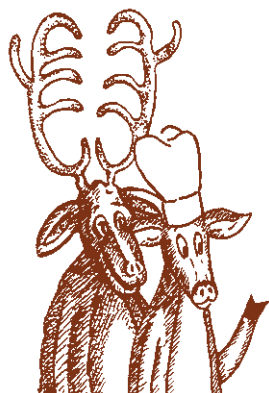

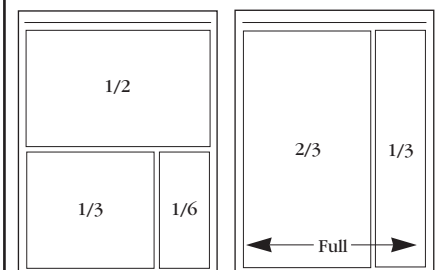

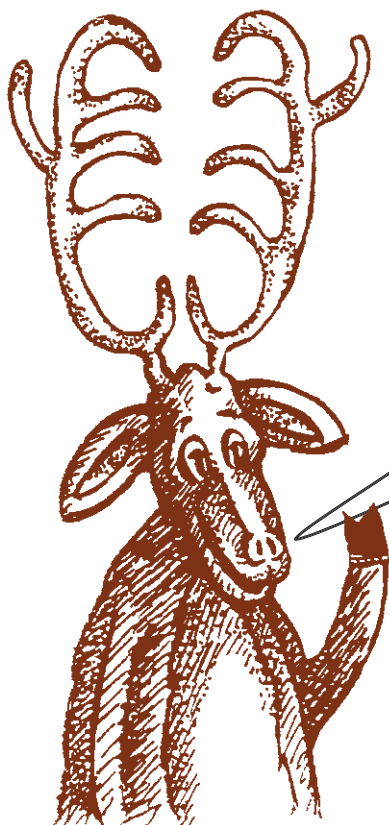

ORDER OF THE GOLDEN FEATHER

NOMINATIONS DUE IN MARCH

The VBA Order of the Golden Feather was created to honor those persons who have given unselfishly of their time and talents toward the betterment of archery and archers. Recipients are persons who possess the virtues of sportsmanship, character, morals, integrity and friendship. As a reflection of the substance for membership, only 80 people have been elected to the Order in the past 71 years.

To be qualified, a candidate must be member in good standing of the VBA at the time of nomination, must have a minimum of ten successive years' membership in the VBA and must be sponsored by three VBA members of good standing or by a VBA Club.

This article is a reminder that candidates must be submitted to the Board of Directors at the March meeting for this year. Nominations must be in writing and be signed by sponsoring individuals or a Club officer. Successful nominees have always performed duties or had an impact outside their immediate club.
