



# VBA State Indoor Sectional Championship Hosted by The Belvoir Bowhunters

DIRECTIONS: Entrance to Fort Belvoir's south post on weekends is through Pence Gate only; Tulley Gate is closed Saturdays and Sundays. Exit U.S. Route 1 (Richmond Highway) at traffic light at Belvoir Road. This "T" intersection is the main entrance to Fort Belvoir at Pence Gate. Obtain a temporary vehicle pass at the visitor center beyond the control point by presenting driver's license and vehicle registration. Proceed south on Belvoir Road to the first traffic light at 12th Street and turn right onto 12th St. Follow 12th St through the next traffic signal at Gunston Road. Beyond Gunston Rd, 12th Street becomes Pohick Road. Approximately 200 feet past the signal at Gunston Road is a second traffic signal. Turn left at this signal from Pohick Rd onto Theote Road. Proceed approximately one-half mile to a stop sign at Warren Road and turn right. Proceed to Tompkins Basin. The Indoor Range is the first long white building adjacent to the water, and the Fort Belvoir Archery Center is located in the building behind it. Detailed map at: http://belvoirmwr.com/hunting-odr/
