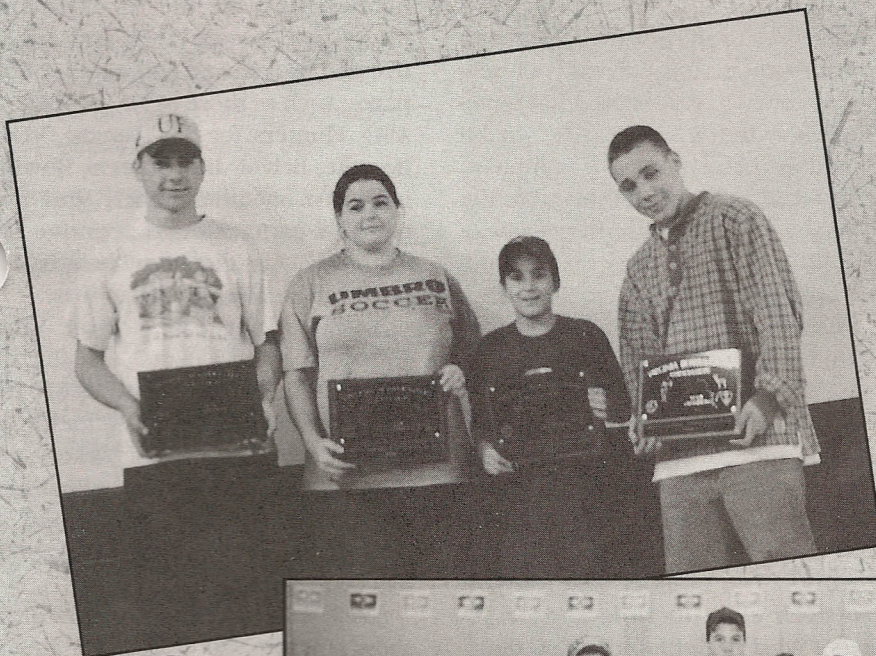

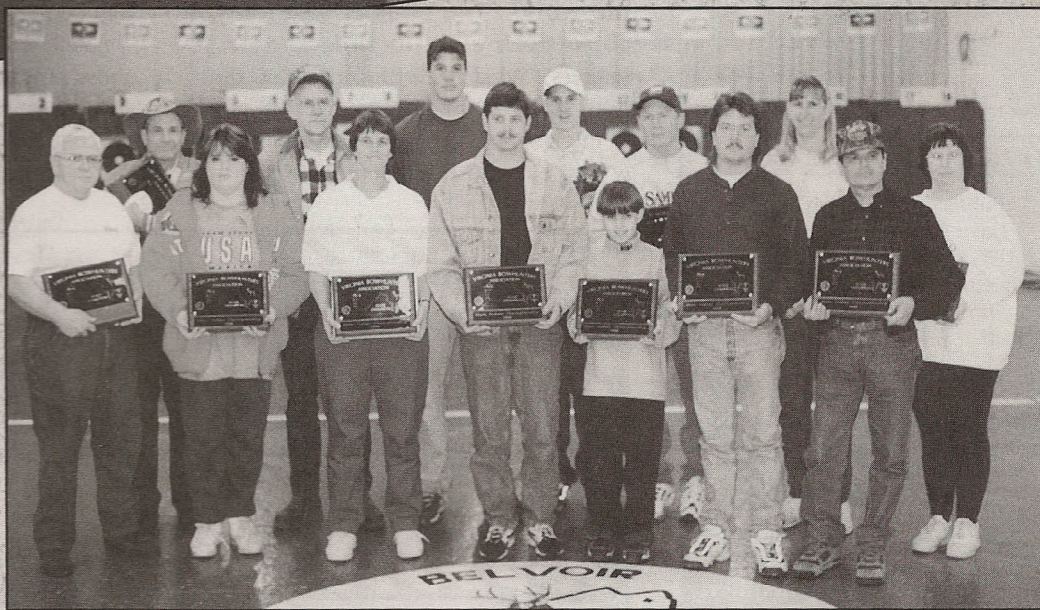

this booklet will be distributed at the June VBA meeting.

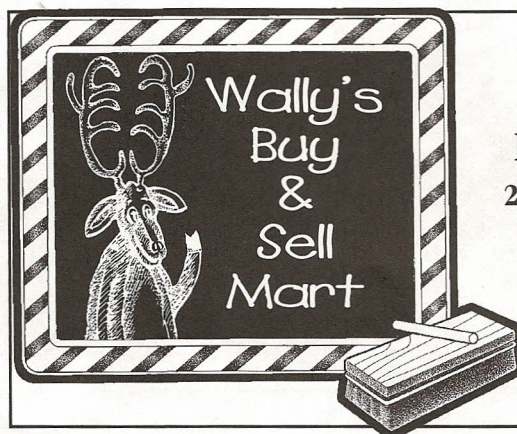

you made a seat for me.*

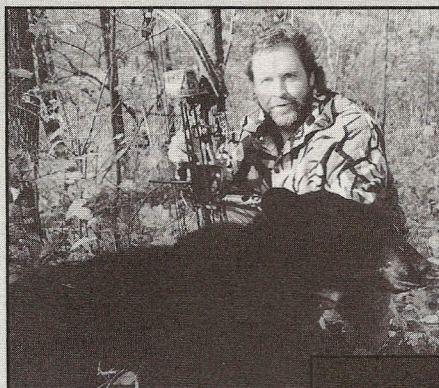
*Never before did I realize,

remember it always.*

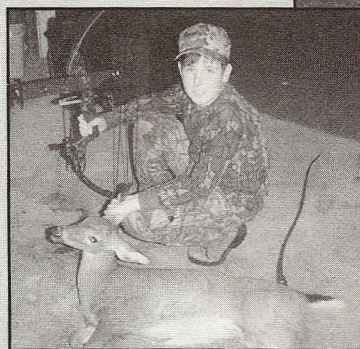

Roast Venison

Cover 5 to 7 pounds leg of venison with cooked marinade (recipe below). Refrigerate at least 24 hours.

To roast: Start heating oven to 450°. Heat shallow open pan in oven. Remove venison from marinade. Sprinkle venison with salt; cover with slices of fat salt pork. Place in heated pan; add enough salad oil to cover bottom of pan. Roast uncovered, basting with salad oil, allowing about 15 to 20 minutes per pound for medium rare meat.

Cooked Marinade:

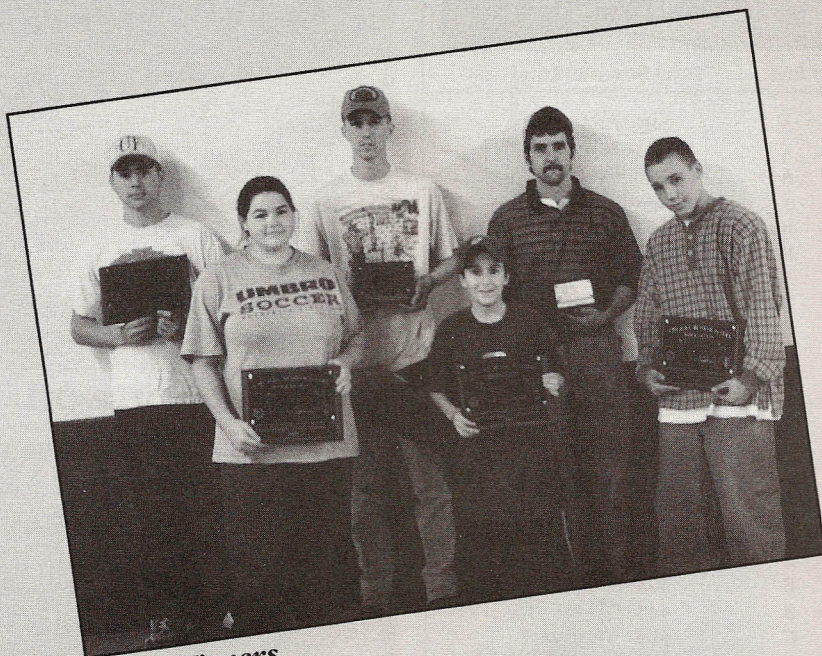
- 1 quart water
- 1½ cups vinegar
- 2 onions, chopped
- 1 carrot, peeled and diced
- 1 clove garlic
- 1 teaspoon dried thyme
- 4 sprigs parsley
- 12 whole black peppercorns
- 1 tablespoon salt

Put all ingredients in saucepan; bring to boil. Simmer, covered, for one hour. Let cool. Pour over venison or other game as recipe directs.

Refrigerate for 24 hours or longer before cooking.

Makes enough to cover 5 to 7 pounds of venison roast.
