New Jersey Loses Black Bear Season

A nimal rights groups put pressure on legislators in New Jersey and influenced Governor Christine Todd Whitman to ask the Fish and Game Council to suspend the necessary black bear hunt scheduled for this September.

The council agreed to the postponement. Press releases from anti-groups indicate that they will push for passage of a ban on bear hunting and are now lobbying to put anti-hunters on the council.

Korean-Style Venison Short Ribs

4 lbs. venison short ribs

5 medium garlic cloves, minced

1/2 cup teriyaki sauce

3 Tbsp. sesame oil

2 tsp. gingerroot, minced

3 Tbsp. sugar

2 tsp. white wine vinegar

2 tsp. sesame seeds

1 tsp. pepper

18 pieces green onion, cut 2" - 4" long

Trim fat from venison short ribs. Cut

the meat side of each rib to the bone at 1/2" intervals. Whisk together garlic, teriyaki sauce, sesame oil, gingerroot, sugar, vinegar, sesame seeds and pepper. Add this marinade with ribs and green onions to a plastic bag and marinate in the regrigerator overnight. Turn bag over occassionally. Remove ribs and green onions from the bag. Discard the marinade. Grill the ribs, meaty-side-down, for eight minutes; turn them over and grill for another six minutes, or until medium-rare. Grill the green onions, turning them occassionally, for four minutes, or until they are just browned. Serves six.






