



The 3-D tournament will consist of 25 targets on Saturday and 25 targets on Sunday. McKenzie Natra-Look Targets will be used.

Yardage will be UNMARKED. One arrow, 3 scoring areas on the animal.

Participants will shoot with their competition on assigned targets. Gun-Shot start. Participants will be notified at Registration Check-In "IF" A.M. and P.M. start times are utilized. 


