From the President

I know there are a lot of folks out there who still question why their club belongs to the VBA. This is a question I've spoken to before, but it still comes up, so I'd like to try to address it one more time. First off, what exactly is the VBA? It is a group of Archery Clubs from around Virginia that come together to promote Archery and Bowhunting. Quoting from our Constitutions, the purpose of the VBA is to "....foster, expand and perpetuate the use of the bow in hunting all legal game; to cooperate with conservation organizations, Game and Fish Commission, and Forestry Services in their efforts for preservation of our natural resources and wildlife; to promote and encourage all approaches to competitive archery activities within the State of Virginia; and to generally require the highest standards of sportsman-like conduct in all phases of archery." To the folks that don't care for the VBA, is there something there you disagree with? Promoting all forms of Archery and Bowhunting? Cooperating with the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries and Forestry Service to protect and preserve our wildlife resources so our children and their children will be able to enjoy them? Promoting competitive archery and sportsman-like conduct? Perhaps some feel that the purpose is fine, but the VBA doesn't do a good job executing these goals. But who really runs the VBA? It is your club Delegate. He or she meets quarterly with Delegates from other Clubs around Virginia and they establish the rules, policies, procedures, tournament/shooting rules, fees, shoot schedules, and all the other things the VBA covers. Very often they must take on complex issues and balance their respective club's position with the needs of other clubs. But in the end, they come together, and find a common way forward that supports and stays true to the purpose that brings them all together. Our Archery and Bowhunting programs across Virginia are better for it. So if you have and issue with the way the VBA policies, procedures, fees, or any other aspect of how it is run, have that discussion with your Club Delegate. They can share with you all the reasons why the VBA is structured and operates the way it does. And don't forget to thank them for taking time out of their busy lives to represent you and your club in your organization that promotes Archery and Bowhunting across Virginia!

From the Executive Vice President



From the Publicity Director

So, "What's New for 2019?" That is up to the VBA Clubs! Only you can answer these questions. How can we improve on increasing membership, getting more clubs & Pro Shops to charter with the VBA. The 4th Quarter membership in 2017 was 1,416 compare to 1,035 in 2018. The same for Adults, Youths, Bowhunter Members, Head of Household, they were all down! Fortunately, we still have 16 clubs, but? Other questions, how can we increase participation at State Tournaments, club shoots, our Annual Awards Banquets and other events our clubs have. What about the schools that participate in the NASP program? After they graduate, where do they go from there when they want to continue to be involved in archery and bowhunting? The financial status of the VBA doesn't look promising as well as some of our clubs. As members, we need to reach-out to archery, bowhunting, parks and recreational and other organizations to join the VBA. Let them know what the VBA is all about, its clubs, what we have to offer such as, archery, bowhunting educational programs and much more. All the 2019 VBA meetings and State Tournaments are in each FLIGHT and on the website. I noticed that some of our clubs are posting their shoots on the VBA Facebook and that's great! It's all there. Enough said on that!

Besides, the 2019 VBA State Indoor Sectional that will be on February 23rd & 24th, hosted by Belvoir Bowhunters, Kingsboro Bowmen, Bowhunters of Rockingham and Sherwood Archers, we have our 24th Annual Awards Banquet on Saturday, March 30th at the New Market Fire & Rescue Department Social Hall in New Market starting at 4:30 p.m. Our guest speaker is Frank Mundy, retired VDGIF Game Warden and author. We will be recognizing our Bowhunters, Tournament Archers, our Order of the Golden Feather recipients, Robin Vogel & Jerry Wenzel; and, our Silver Arrow recipients from: BBH, Steve Richards; BOR, Lowell Hertzler & Owen Shifflet; New River, Donna Hall and Two Rivers, David Roberson.

Shannon Nesselrodt, VBA Hunting VP, mentioned that the following bills are in the General Assembly: VA HB 2340 – 2019: Virginia resident hunting license tax deduction. Establishes a tax deduction for the amount an individual pay for Virginia resident hunting licenses purchased from the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. This may be applied to the amount paid for no more than three licenses per year. The provisions of this bill apply to taxable years beginning on and after January 1, 2019; and,

VA HB 2687 – 2019: Special license for hunting elk. Authorizes the Board of Game and Inland Fisheries

(the Board) to create a special license for hunting elk. Such license shall be required in addition to general hunting licenses. The bill authorizes the Board to establish guidelines (i) related to selection of applicants for eligibility to purchase a special elk license and (ii) l elk license and (ii) permitting the transfer of special elk licenses to individuals or wildlife conservation organizations whose mission is to ensure the conservation of Virginia's wildlife resources. The bill sets a nonrefundable application fee of \$15 for residents and \$20 for nonresidents and a special elk license fee at no more than \$40 for residents and \$400 for nonresidents.

Also, we would like to see the VBA sponsor a Youth Archery Hunt on Youth/Apprentice Hunting day this year.

In the recent Hunters for the Hungry Newsletter, they mention they had some "Good News – Bad News." The Good News - the processors all around the state are reporting that the number of deer being donated is up! In some areas as much as three times as many. They can reach or possibly even exceed their goal of providing 1.3 million servings of venison!

And the Bad News – they have lost two major grants this year! Walmart, who has been donating \$50,000 through a state giving program, has discontinued their state grant program. Also, they were not chosen by the Altria Company Employee Community Fund to receive a grant his year. This is a very competitive grant and they were very fortunate to receive it 12 years in a row. Their grant ranged between \$20,000 and \$40,000. For those that wish to give a monetary donation(s) or purchase raffle tickets, go to their website at www.h4hungry.org.







To enter Fort Belvoir, all non-DoD affiliated passengers of every vehicle must undergo a personal background check using the person's social security number. Allow up to one hour (usually faster) to process through Tully Gate, depending on the line at the gate. All must have a state/federal issued picture ID.

Directions: Exit US Route 1 (Richmond Hwy) at the traffic signal at Pohick Road. This intersection is the Tully Gate entrance to Fort Belvoir. Drive up Pohick Road to the security control point/visitor center and process through base security. Proceed south on Pohick Road to the first traffic light at Theote Road and turn right. Proceed approximately ½ mile to a stop sign at Warren Road and turn right. Proceed about ½ mile and turn right at the bottom of the hill. The archery range is in Outdoor Recreation, the white building (Bldg 778) on the right.







This is one of Wally and Winnie's favorites - Wild Turkey Stir-Fry

1 1/2 tablespoons cornstarch

1/4 cup orange juice

1 (1-pound) boneless, skinless turkey breast, cut into strips

3/4 cup chicken broth

1 1/2 tablespoons soy sauce

2 1/2 tablespoons vegetable oil

1 clove garlic, minced

1 1/2 teaspoons ground ginger

1 cup chopped broccoli

1 1/2 cup snow peas or green beans

1 medium red bell pepper, cut into thin strips

3/4 cup sliced green onion

1 medium carrot, cut into thin strips

2 cups cooked white or wild rice

In a shallow glass bowl, combine orange juice and cornstarch. Add turkey, and stir to combine. Cover, and chill for 2 hours. Drain turkey, and discard juice mixture. Combine chicken broth and soy sauce. Set aside. In a wok or large skillet on medium heat, add oil, garlic and ginger. Stir-fry for 30 seconds. Add broccoli, turkey and next 4 ingredients, and stir-fry until crisp-tender, about 5 minutes. Stir in broth mixture. Simmer about 1 minute. Serve over rice.







500 Pin Any VBA member that scores 500 or better at a VBA sanctioned shoot on a VBA approved range. The round must be shot from the adult stakes on a field, hunter or field/hunter combination round. The scorecard must be signed by 2 witnesses and sent to the Executive State Secretary.

Perfect Animal Any VBA member that shoots a 20 or higher on each of the 14 unit animal targets for a total score or 280 or more. The round must be shot from the adult stakes on a VBA approved range at a sanctioned VBA shoot. The scorecard must be signed by 2 witnesses.





ORDER OF THE GOLDEN FEATHER

NOMINATIONS DUE IN MARCH

The VBA Order of the Golden Feather was created to honor those persons who have given unselfishly of their time and talents toward the betterment of archery and archers. Recipients are persons who possess the virtues of sportsmanship, character, morals, integrity and friendship. As a reflection of the substance for membership, only 86 people have been elected to the Order in the past 78 years.

To be qualified, a candidate must be member in good standing of the VBA at the time of nomination, must have a minimum of ten successive years' membership in the VBA and must be sponsored by three VBA members of good standing or by a VBA Club.

This article is a reminder that candidates must be submitted to the Board of Directors at the March meeting for this year. Nominations must be in writing and be signed by sponsoring individuals or a Club officer. Successful nominees have always performed duties or had an impact outside their immediate club.
