Now, as we begin another term of officers, we need to give them our support as well. As Paul takes the helm, he will have Dave Burpee as Executive Vice-President & Flight Editor, Joyce Cameron as Recording Secretary and Ed Bickham as Hunting Vice-President as well as the other officers.

<u>VBA State Open</u>: Much thanks to Sherwood Archers, who did a super job in welcoming 94 archers. There were 10 new records set at the State Open as well.

<u>Upcoming VBA State Tournaments</u>: Two more tournaments are on the agenda with Manahoac hosting the Fall 3-D Classic on August 15th & 16th and Augusta Archers hosting the State Closed on September 5th & 6th. Please join them in supporting archery. Further details will be in FLIGHT and on the website.

<u>VBA Membership</u>: Marie Bell reported for the second quarter that membership was 1,137, an increase of 41 over 2008. New members still remain at 192, down by 29. So folks, let's keep plugging away for members.

<u>VBA Banquet Update</u>: As you know, participation at this year's banquet was not as great as it has been in the past. In spite of this, VBA profits totaled \$234.31. Kudos goes to Dave Burpee and others who made it work as well as to Karen Holson, who gave a great presentation on the VDGIF – NAS Program.

Also, congratulations to the following clubs who need to be recognized for their increase in membership: Augusta Archers – 8.1%, Manahoac Bowmen – 6.2%, NORVA – 5.7%, Sherwood Archers – 7.7%, Triangle Archers, 25%, Walton Park Bowhunters – 50%, Blackwater Bowhunters – 10.1%, Prince William Archers – 24%, Wythe Bowhunters – 40%, Dixie Bowmen – 45%, Massanutten Archery Club – 53%, Belvoir Bowhunters – 7.0% and Singers Glenn Bowbenders – 37.5%. Congratulations to all of you, including the other clubs that are working hard to increase membership.

Order of the Golden Feather: The following candidates to the O.G.F. were submitted at the June meeting: Joyce Cameron, Jim Little and Joe McManus. In September, the Order will report their selections to the VBA Executive State Secretary and request that the recipient(s) attend the March banquet.

<u>VBA Program Updates</u>: Jerry Wenzel will be giving us an update on the activities and progress of the VBA ASA Program. Mark Gaunter will update us on the IBEP training and instructors dates, locations, and the regional coordinators names for FLIGHT & the website.

<u>Commercial & Pro Shops</u>: As one of Paul's first tasks, he began contacting some of the pro shops in Virginia. As a result, Hoffman's Archery and Wilcox Bait & Tackle will be joining the VBA.

The VBA charter fees for commercial & pro shops are \$200.00 per year and VBA gives them a 1/6th page ad in the quarterly issue of FLIGHT. If any member and/or club is aware of other sporting shops that would be interested in joining the VBA, please have them contact Paul Vogel.


