Changes in VBA Officers. As you may know, Bob Seltzer has stepped down as President. Our new President, Kevin Reedy and the Hunting Vice-President, Dave Burpee, along with the other elected officers, were sworn in at the June meeting. The NBEP and Publicity Director positions will be filled through appointment by the full Executive Board.

Bob, thank you for your hard work and dedication to the VBA over the past years. We wish you much health and enjoyment of Mother Nature and your family!

VBA Website. You can now access the website from any search engine by simply typing: Virginia Bowhunters. All Domain Names and private registration have been secured.

Trailblazer Events. We would like to thank the New River Bowhunters who helped the U.S. Sportsmen Alliance & the Boy Scouts conduct their Trailblazer event held on April 28th. They taught some 350 youths, ranging from one to 15 years of age, giving them a hands-on archery opportunity. Also, thanks to the Two River Archers and the Camerons and their volunteers, who taught the basic skills of archery to some 400 youths ranging from the first through the fifth grades at Camp Snyder in Haymarket.

IBEP Classes. Upcoming IBEP classes can be found in this issue of FLIGHT and on the VBA website. Also, these IBEP classes will soon be found on the VDGIF website.

VBA Archery Education Classes. Many times we receive inquiries regarding our Archery Education classes. Please let me know when and where they will be held so we can publish them in FLIGHT and on our website.

NWTF Family Outdoor Festival. This event was the first in Virginia. Although it was not a success, the volunteers at the Archery arena enjoyed demonstrating the basics of archery. Two VDGIF Hunter Ed instructors from the Tidewater area took some 200 VBA packets and many FLIGHT issues to be distributed to various sporting stores, Boy & Girl Scout groups and to military installations in the surrounding areas.

VDGIF. Effective July 1, 2007, Virginia game wardens will be titled 'Conservation Police Officers.' Throughout Virginia, wildlife enforcement officers often intersect with our county and State Police, and find themselves dealing with people who do not understand their law enforcement authority. The title change to include the word "police" will let folks know who they are and allow them to better serve all citizens of Virginia.

National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP). The DGIF/ NASP in Virginia have 198 school educators that have completed the Basic Archery Instructor certification. Currently, 70 schools in 27 counties are conducting this program in their schools with another 27 awaiting equipment. In addition, several schools have added Hunter Education as part of their physical education and health curriculum. This is a two-fold effort to get folks interested in archery and in joining a VBA club in their area.

Woods & Waters. I have asked the editor to add our upcoming VBA Tournaments & IBEP classes to their Archery Event section.

From the Hunting Vice-President

My column in the last issue of FLIGHT dealt with the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (VDGIF) conducting its Periodic Regulation Review and Amendment Process in 2007. This process occurs every two years and is the mechanism whereby the VDGIF addresses and considers possible amendments to the state regulations it uses to govern wildlife, hunting, trapping, fishing, and boating.

This article picks up the same theme to keep you posted on developments and to encourage your personal participation. There is nothing related to bowhunting in Virginia that will be more important during the next two years than the regulation review and approval cycle that ends in October. As a result, you can expect to read more about this topic in the next issues of FLIGHT. Further, I suspect (and hope!) there will be much discussion about recommended changes during individual VBA Club meetings.

The first part of the process occurred April 10 through June 15. During that period, the staff preliminary recommendations were posted on the VDGIF web site for public comment via e-mail, mail or in-person comment. The next major step is the July 17 VDGIF Board meeting where the staff will summarize the public discussion and present its refined set of recommendations. The Board will also receive public comment at this meeting. I will be present at this and all other relevant Board meetings to represent the views of the VBA and by extension the thousands of bowhunters in Virginia.

At a July 17 meeting, the Board will approve a set of Proposed Regulations and a public comment period will be open through September 24. This is the chance for every bowhunter to have a direct influence on the process and to comment on the possible changes. Comments can be made on-line through the VDGIF web site (www.dgif.virginia.gov), via e-mail to RegComments@dgif.virginia.gov, or via regular mail to Dept. of Game and Inland Fisheries, Attn: Policy Analyst and Regulatory Coordinator, 4016 West Broad Street, Richmond VA 23230. Also, there will be a Board meeting on August 21 at which public comments will be accepted.

The public comment period closes September 24 and the Board will meet October 16 to take final action. The new regulations or regulation amendments adopted will take effect January 1, March 1 and July 1, 2008, depending on the species involved.

As an additional part of the process described above, the VDGIF staff will meet (on request and subject to availability) with constituent groups, local government officials, or other groups in local communities to address specific regulatory issues of interest. I know the four northern Virginia counties, where there is a tremendous urban deer problem, has had at least one such meeting where a variety of solutions were discussed.

The solutions discussed included allowance for antlered deer mistaken for antlerless during antlerless-only seasons; establishment of an early antlerless-only firearms season; extension of the late antlerless-only firearm season; institution of a requirement to harvest an antlerless deer before harvesting a second antlered deer (e.g., earn-a-buck); and, removal of daily antlerless limits. Non-regulatory approaches to address the issue are also being considered, such as education and price reduction of bonus antlerless tags.

This is definitely a year when many regulation changes are possible. My presence at VDGIF meetings will ensure that VBA issues articulated by member clubs and the VBA Hunting Committee are a part of the process. Each VBA member is also encouraged to participate directly in the process via one of the methods provided above. For example, the VDIGF web site already has multiple public comments about many of the topics of interest in northern Virginia. VBA members can reinforce or rebut comments already posted as well as introduce their opinion on new issues.

Remember, you can't complain about the outcome of an election if you don't vote, and in the same manner you can't complain about new hunting regulations if you don't make your views known.

I will continue to keep you posted on this important topic.

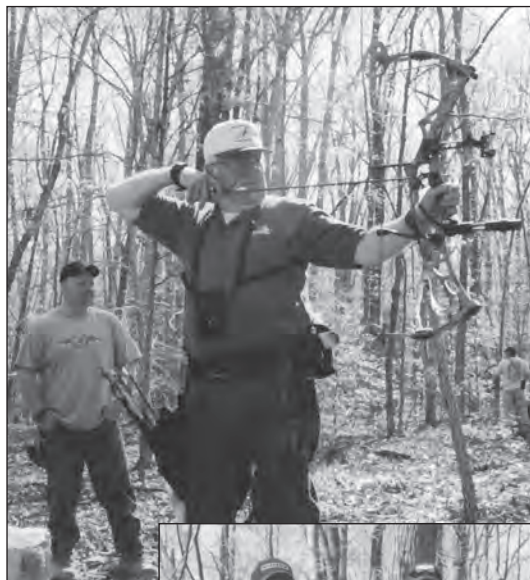

BLACKWATER BOWHUNTERS OPEN NEW RANGE

The range will host spot tournaments sanctioned by the VBA and 3-D animal tournaments. An annual tournament, featuring archers from throughout Virginia will also be held this fall.

The range is located at 1080 Wirtz Road. From Rocky Mount, take U.S. 220 north to the stoplight at Plateau Plaza, turn right onto Virginia 697 (Wirtz Road) and go approximately one mile. A sign for the range is on the right.

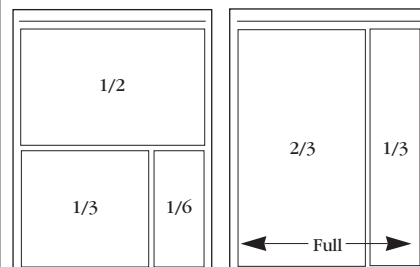

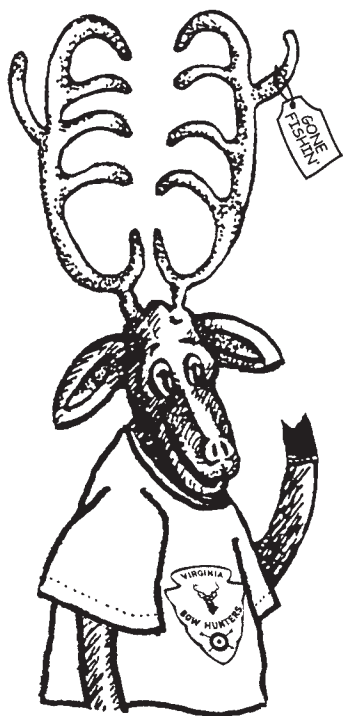
