


A REPORT ON THE MID-ATLANTIC REGIONAL FIELD ARCHERY TOURNAMENT

The ranges of the Richmond Archers were the site of the 1969 Mid-Atlantic Regional Field Archery Tournament held on June 21 and 22. The two-day shoot, consisting of a hunter and field round on Saturday and an animal round on Sunday, was a complete success. VBA Meeting highlights

Due to the mass confusion and disapproval of the Handicap system as used in "Flight Competition" it was decided that VBA would drop this method of grouping.

Beginning immediately all clubs should use the "Class Competition" system as outlined in the NFAA Blue Book on Handicaps pages 8 & 9. If you do not have this book, write to Nancy Western for a copy. It was also decided to give clubs permission to vary the point breakdown slightly to suit the local needs. All class grouping must be by handicap and all shooting within the class by raw score.

Since going to this system it was decided that the Animal Round will remain as one of the State Shoot rounds. Repeating, the Animal Round will be shot at the State Shoot.




