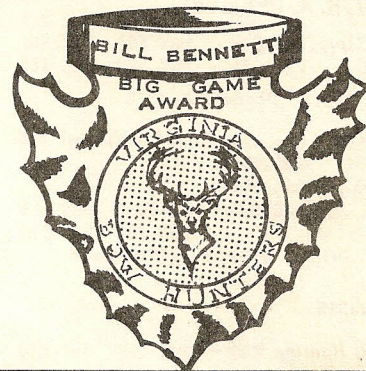
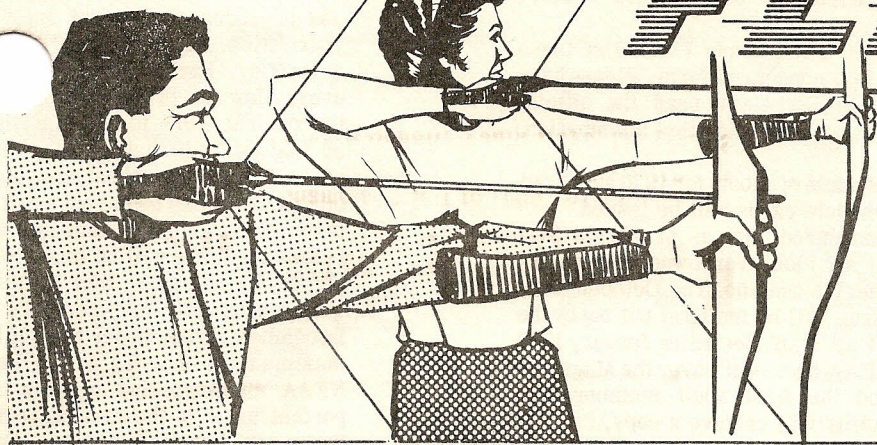


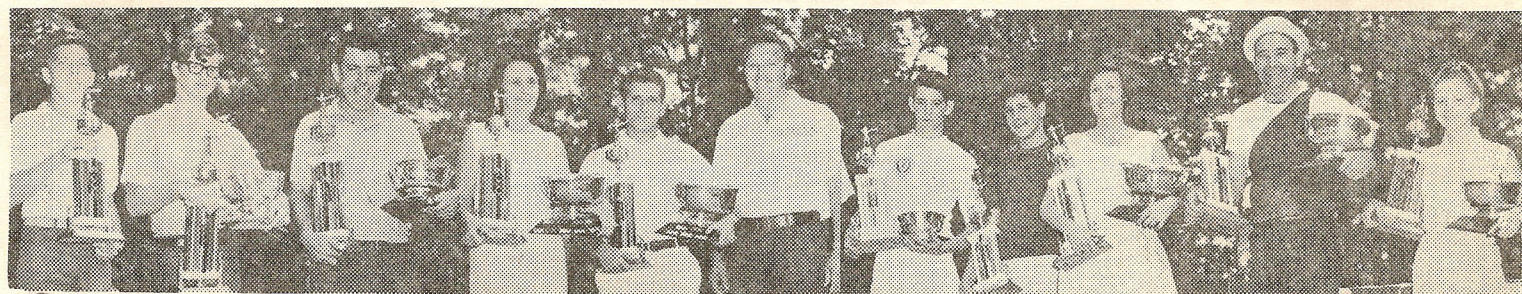

23rd ANNUAL VBA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

The Sherwood Archers of Roanoke, Va. was host for the 23rd State Championship Tournament with a turn out of about 185 archers. Good weather prevailed throughout the week end and everyone enjoyed the affair.

This year's shoot saw more new Champions crowned than I can remember for one year. Elmer Moore and Virginia Dillow won the Bare Bow honors for the first time and James Mitchell and Margaret Shelley took the Free Style. A first time for James, Tom Frye and Carolyn Izon won in the Bowhunters division.

Stiff competition prevailed in both the Bare Bow and Free Style men division. Elmer Moore won over Ed Rose by only six points and had to beat out Warren Cowles the defending champion and the new World Amateur Champion. James Mitchell won over James Quarles our defending FS champion by only one point. A complete breakdown of all winners listed below.

HIGHLIGHTS OF SEPT. VBA MEETING

Due to a full issue I will list these events in a condensed form. Please have your Club Secretary read the official minutes for more detailed information.

1. Schedule of Shoots for 1970 approved. Schedule cards will be issued.
2. Announced that as of August 31st NFAA took over ownership of Archery Magazine. The October issue will be the first put out by the NFAA staff. Beginning January 1970 NFAA dues will cover the Magazine and the first adult member of a family will receive a copy.
3. Lucille Darnell was elected to fill the vacant position of NAA Director on the VBA Executive Committee. This vacated office was the result of Mr. Tim Daily moving out of the state.
4. Bids accepted for the VBA main tournaments as follows:
Va. State Field Championship — Sherwood Archers, Roanoke.
Va. State Indoor Championship — Norva, Fairfax.
Va. State Amateur Championship — Cub Run Archers, Centerville.
Va. State Open Championship — Augusta Archers, Staunton.
Va. State Broadhead Championship — West Point Archery, West Point.
Greenwood Archers, Petersburg.
Va. State Jamboree — Wythe Bowhunters, Wytheville.
5. A time limit for shooting all Official Rounds in any VBA approved tournament was approved and set at 3-1/2 hours for the Animal and International Rounds, 4 hours for the Field Round, and 4-1/2 hours for the Hunters Round.
6. A proposed change in the handling of ballots for election of VBA Officers was presented and approval was given for a balloting of this. Your official ballot, listing the proposed change, will be found on page 3 of this issue. Please read it carefully, cut out, mark approve or disapprove, and mail to Nancy Western address on reverse side of the ballot. VOTE.
7. A proposal was made to change the By-Laws so that all main VBA Championship tournaments will be included under the 2 year option plan that now apply only to the Field and Indoor Championship tournaments. This will be voted on at the next VBA meeting.
8. VBA will conduct an instructional session for all new club Presidents, Secretaries, and Range Captains on Sat. prior to the regular Sunday meeting in January. It is strongly urged that all clubs send these officers to this meeting. Topics to

be covered will include VBA rules and procedures as might apply to your office. How to run and conduct a meeting, Parliamentary procedures, How to properly conduct a tournament, How to group archers so that you will have a minimum of hold ups in a shoot and many others. This has been requested by many clubs for some time now and I am sure there will be much to be gained by attending this meeting.

9. VBA needs 300 new members by December 31st in order to have the maximum of 4 votes at the Feb. NFAA meeting. This is very important as it is the same vote that the much larger States will have and will be a bargain point when our proposals are voiced at the meeting. So how about your club putting on a membership drive during the hunting season. Any member received by VBA prior to December 31st will count. Don't forget our Bowhunter Membership when you meet a hunter who has no desire to belong to a club. They will also count toward this goal and in this small way they can contribute something to the organization responsible for getting and holding their right to hunt with the bow and arrow.

At the September meeting, a motion was duly made that the Constitution of VBA be changed as follows:

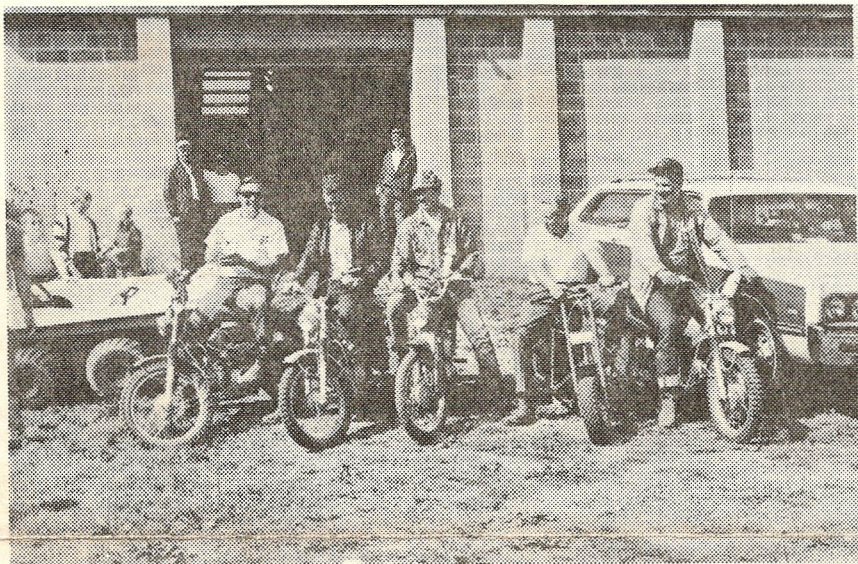
Change the fourth sentence of Article 4, Section 3 to read as follows:

"All voting for candidates will be done by mail ballots which are to be sent to all members of affiliated clubs or groups and associated members within 30 days after the third quarterly meeting, provided that there is more than one candidate nominated for one or more offices. In the absence of a mail ballot, the Board of Directors will elect the slate of officers as proposed by the Nominating Committee."
