Those clubs who turned scores into Nancy Lee were informed that those scores were not valid and returned. I would strongly suggest that the President and his/her officers familiarize themselves with both the NFAA Rule Book and our own VBA constitution and by-laws. This would eliminate any problems in the future.

It is very important that a Director from each club be present at the September meeting for the scheduling session. This meeting will be on Saturday night at 7:30 p.m.

To make this session go smoother and quicker it would be to each club's advantage to have a meeting in their zone to set dates for their shoots.

When the bids for the 1987 state shoots are decided in September, it will be necessary to announce at that time the tournament chairperson for that shoot. That chairperson will be required to attend a special meeting at the January VBA meeting for the purpose of going over the requirements of hosting state shoots. This has become necessary since the past state contracts have not been followed. The time and place will be furnished to those involved.

The VBA Pins have been ordered and should be in sometime soon. A large order has been made to try to keep from running out next year.
