These two people have given willingly and unselfishly their time, talent and endless energy in the devel-opment and success of VBA for well over a decade.



Sherwood Archers proposed that winners of the State Open Championship be awarded a state patch, as it is done in the State Closed Championship and State Indoor Championship.

A. Use the current state championship patch.

B. Use the current patch with the word "Open" added. (Vote for either A or B.)


Triangle Bowhunters move that the State Open be moved to the first weekend in June for 1984.

Seminole Archers proposed that all participants should have 2 posted scores on their card within 90 days prior to State Open Tournament.

Manahoac Bowmen proposed that the club be allowed to host a second trophy shoot annually in lieu of one pin shoot. 25¢ from registration of each shooter would be given to VBA to cover lost income from pins.

Manahoac Bowmen proposed that the cub and youth division be broken down into equipment classes, with all the same as the adult division.

It is moved that consideration be given to using part of the conservation fund money for the purchase of Bill Bennett Big Game Awards or for some purpose such as better awards for state shoots. The money comes from tournament archers and I feel it would serve a better purpose than the way it is now being utilized.


