Agenda Items Of The June 2001 VBA Meeting

■ CORRECTION TO MARCH

AGENDA ITEM: Motion to eliminate office of Field Governor, duties to be assumed by the NFAA Director. This motion was ruled passed with 9 for and 8 opposed. Following adjournment, it was discovered that this would constitute a By-law change and would need a two-thirds majority vote in order to pass. **FAILED**

■ "That the State Indoor Tournament return to previous policy of being conducted at multiple sites." Effective January 1, 2002. **FAILED**

■ Add to Article 16, Section 2, A -

"(1) A shooter is allowed to shoot more than one style of shooting at the Indoor State Tournament and be eligible for awards provided they register and pay for all styles shot and there is ample space/time available on the shooting line." Effective January 1, 2002.

PASSED

■ Add to Article 16, Section 2, A -

"(2) The maximum shooting distance for the Traditional class to be 50 yards." Effective immediately.
