

Attention All Club Secretaries: Please remember that ALL shoots that are listed on the VBA Schedule card, with the exception of one (1) annual, is subject to the 25 cents per shooter fee. This includes indoor, 3-D, and pin shoots, as well as all animal shoots. For example, if your club hosts a pin/3-D shoot, 25 cents must be mailed to my office for all shooters. Don't forget that the tournament reports for official rounds shot (field, hunter, or half of each) is due in my office the Friday following your shoot. There are some club secretaries that either do not understand the policy or that are simply lax in getting these reports and monies to me.


Remember, too, that effective at the March 1994 VBA meeting, pin shoot fees are now \$5 for the first shoote \$4/second and \$3 each additional. (TI \$4 and \$3 fees apply to families only.)


Open to All Archers and Bowhunters Registration Fees: \$20 Single \$40 Family (3 or more)
