From the President

Dear Member:

I write this letter to let you know the VBA has been operating in the red the last 10 or so years. You have entrusted me as your President to rectify this disheartening situation. Some of the steps we have taken include forming a Financial Committee to look into where the organization's money is going. Our biggest expenses are 1. Flight, 2. Executive State Secretary/Treasurer Salary, 3. Officers Travel expenses 4. Awards.

What we have done and are proposing are as follows. 1. Went from four issues of FLIGHT a year to two. This should save us around \$6,000 dollars a year. 2. Executive State Secretary/ Treasurer Salary: An agenda item was introduced by the Hunting VP/NORVA rep to split this position into two positions (Treasurer and Corresponding Secretary), and go back to both of these being unpaid positions upon Marie's retirement. This change should save us \$5,000-\$6,000 dollars a year. 3. Officers Travel expenses: an agenda item was introduced to go to two in person meetings and two Zoom meetings a year, which should save us around \$3,000 dollars a year. 4. Awards: an agenda item was introduced to do away with the system and only make awards to the top three in each style. For example, we only made around \$60 on this year's State Indoor. I am requiring that the yearly audit of the books be published in the FLIGHT magazine. Also, we are working on getting our 501(c)3 tax exempt nonprofit status! We believe that will help the VBA in multiple ways. Another initiative we have introduced is adding a new Associate Membership for anyone wanting to join that is not a member of a Club.

What would YOU like to see out of the VBA? I think we should be the Voice of the Virginia Bowhunter pushing for legislation in Richmond. After all, we are the Virginia Bowhunters Association! Our State Tournaments are important, and we will continue to host and work on improving and expanding them. I just think we can do better with promoting the sport of archery and archery hunting. As a VBA member, I would ask you to let your Club VBA Delegate know how you feel so they can bring an accurate representation of your desires to the quarterly meeting. The next meeting will be at Bowhunters of Rockingham on June 6, 2021 at 9am. You are more than welcome to attend!

In closing I would like to say I take this job very seriously and have listened to a lot of you out on the range or at meetings ,etc. I understand that in some areas, the old ways of doing things are not working and if we want to be around another 80 years, we need to make changes.

I think it's important that your dues go for something productive for this great Association! Thank you for your continued support.

From the Field Vice President

As the 2021 season begins, we are still challenged by the COVID restrictions. With the help of several members, we came up with a virtual shoot. We had approximately 80 shooters, all the scores tabulated and awards sent. Any club who wants to host a 2022 state shoot should submit their bid at the June meeting. All bids will be considered and voted on at the September meeting. The scheduling meeting has been moved to September 19, 2021 at 8:30 am because the banquet has been moved to Saturday September 18th providing all goes well.

There are some motions to change the 3-D shoots to 30 targets at the state shoots only. Both Fall and Spring will be a two-day shoot—shoot one or two days and count the highest score. This will make it easier for some to shoot if they can only make one day. We also want to do away with the classification system. The current system doesn't work well with the decreased number of shooters and will save money on the awards. Also, we want to limit the State Champion pins to one per style and division per person. After one pin is awarded, that person would only receive the drop down.

As the year continues, I hope the restrictions are lifted and more will be able to attend the state shoots. Any club needing an inspection should contact me to schedule an appointment.

Stay safe and hopefully we will be able to have a good turnout at the banquet on September 18th.

AGENDA ITEMS

Agenda Item 1

SEPARATE DUTIES TO BE VOLUNTEERS THUS REMOVING THE \$5 COST OF EACH VBA MEMBER

Constitution Section 4.5, VBA bylaws Article 8: Dis-establish the Executive Secretary/Treasurer and establish a separate Corresponding Secretary and Treasurer with the said responsibilities below as elected volunteers. They shall be elected positions filled by volunteers, the same as the other officers. This shall be enacted upon retirement, resignation, by reason of death, disqualification, or otherwise, by majority vote of a quorum of the Board of Directors. Justification: With membership down to under 1,000 head of households and the financial shape the organization is in it does not warrant a paid officer to receive for services a salary of \$5.00 per member.

CORRESPONDING SECRETARY: 1. It shall be the duty of the Corresponding Secretary to accept dues, maintain and submit membership records for the organization. The Corresponding Secretary shall file all required Insurance, Tax, Lease, and Regulatory reports; act as custodian of the VBA corporate seal, affixing an impression thereof to any papers requiring the same; process non-financial vouching documents for receipts include, but are not limited to, membership applications, tournaments, reports, and membership renewals. It shall also be his/her duty to receive and submit all necessary correspondence to the Charter clubs, membership, and /or other organizations that the organization may be affiliated with.

TREASURER: 2. It shall be the duty of the treasurer to take charge of the funds of the organization subject to the general supervision and control of the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall, under the direction of the Board of Directors, give negotiate, or endorse such checks, notes, and bills as may be required in conduct of business of the organization. He/she have authority to collect the funds of the organization, and he/she shall deposit all funds so received in such bank/banks as the Board of Directors may from time to time designate. The Treasure shall keep proper books of accounting which shall always be subject to examination by the president, or the Board of Directors or any agent. The Treasurer shall render at all regular scheduled club meetings a statement showing the financial condition of the organization. At the last regular meeting of the membership, the Treasurer shall submit a written statement showing the financial condition of the organization and a detailed report of the receipts, disbursements, and expenses for the calendar year. The Treasurer shall be responsible for such other duties as may be required by the Board of Directors.

Agenda Item 2

AWARD COST OF VBA OF FLIGHT AND STATE CHAMPIONS

Constitution Section, VBA bylaws: Tournament flights will no longer receive a medal. All VBA State tournaments will only award the top 3 scores in each Division or Class. Dis-establish the VBA State Champion Shoulder patch and 1st Place gold medal. **Justification**: With membership down to under 1,000 head of households. And the financial shape the organization is in it does not warrant excess awards identifying the State Champion.

Tournament Awards:

First Place / State Champion. Receive the VBA State Head Pin once, year bar, and VBA state Champion certificate.

- 1. Second Place. Receive the VBA silver medal.
- 2. Third Place. Receive the VBA bronze medal.

Dis-establish:

- 1. Upon completion of using the current inventory of the VBA State Champion patch and 1st Place Gold medal end the purchasing and issuing of them at State tournaments.
- 2. Tournament flights will no longer receive a medal.

Agenda Item 3

TRAVEL COST OF VBA OFFICERS

Constitution Section, VBA bylaws: Establish 2 of the 4 quarterly meetings online in a distributed process. Of the 4 scheduled VBA quarterly meetings, the VBA shall exercise technology and conduct 2 distributed meetings via Zoom or a Zoom like platform to reduce travel cost of the executive board in January and March. **Justification**: With membership down to under 1,000 head of households and the financial shape the organization is in it does not warrant paying the travel cost of the officers. We successfully conducted zoom meeting during calendar 2020.

Modify Quarterly meeting:

1. The Field Vice President will schedule the 4 quarterly meetings as usual. The President shall approve the 2 online meetings in January and March. The Webmaster/Publicity Director will set up and coordinate the Zoom or Zoom like platform for the meetings.

Agenda Item 4

Page 10 Section 15.1.4

Change B to read:

The Fall 3D will be a two-day unmarked distance shoot. Archers have the option of shooting one or two days and counting the highest score. There will be thirty (30) 3D targets with the maximum distance of fifty (50) Yards. Archers have the option of shooting the K50 and K45 at this shoot. If shooting the K50 or K45 and in a group shooting unmarked, you must shoot so other archers cannot see sight setting or range finder. Effective Date-January 1, 2022

Agenda Item 5

Page 10 Section 15.1.2

Change B to read:

The Spring 3D will be a two-day shoot. Archers have the option of shooting one or two days and counting the highest score. Spring 3D is marked distance and will have thirty (30) targets with a maximum of sixty (60) yards. If the archer wants to receive awards in the K50 or K45 he/she must decide at this shoot. Effective January 1, 2022

Justification for the above changes:

In order to align with IBO shooting rules which we use change to 30 targets would line up with rules and archers would be shooting the same at both VBA and IBO Clubs. This rule applies only to state shoots (not club shoots). In order to win a Double Crown award, you must win both shoots in the same division and style. You must decide K45 & K50 at the spring shoot even though it is marked. Change the Fall 3-D to a two-day and only count one score will make it easier for some to shoot who can't make both days. All items below are rules that only change if the two motions above are passed. Dropping the classification system which isn't working because of low attendance at the shoots will help decrease the number of awards. These changes will only apply to State Closed and Indoor shoots since the State Open has shooters from other states and non-members shooting with no classifications.

Page 21 Standing Rules—Add Rule 22:

State Champion pins will be awarded to first place winners along with a drop down showing the shoot and year. An archer is to receive only one head pin for each style and division shooting. After that, only a drop down will be awarded. The Field Vice President will maintain a list of State Champions with the styles and divisions to be updated after each state shoot and send current list to clubs hosting future shoots. Effective January 1, 2022 *Justification:*

This change will save the cost of State Champion pins as the drop downs are far less expensive.

APPLICATION FOR VBA INDIVIDUAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

Robin Hood Any VBA member that telescopes an arrow in the highest scoring area on the target. (3-D targets and Maple Leaf Animals, the arrow would only need to be in the kill area). The Robin Hood must be shot at a VBA sanctioned shoot on a VBA approved range. The scorecard must be signed by 2 witnesses, accompanied by \$5.00 and sent to the VBA Executive State Secretary.



A hunt-cation to remember. It started off with an unusual start. 11/20 was the first day of five daily Neupogen injections as I began the process of building up my stem cells in preparation of donating bone marrow for my Aunt with Leukemia.

That same day I headed to my stand here in Fairfax County not too far from our archery club. It was 11 a.m. I previously sat this spot for the past 2 days, a morning sit and an all day sit. A doe in heat was being chased by a spike, a 6-point, and bringing up the rear, a mega giant, the buck I've been waiting for. This was the first time I had seen him from the stand within 100 yards. My heart rate is JACKED. But I saw them running in the opposite direction of my stand. I am quickly brought back down to reality as they are all gone. I was coming into the final hour of hunting light. Sunset



was set for 4:52 p.m, with legal shooting 30 minutes after that. I knew I had to make a move. As the group of deer ran off past me, I knew I had to try and do something to bring them back in range. I let out three different toned grunts, followed by two doe bleats. I saw the height and the mass of my target buck's antlers coming my way, responding to the calls. He was actually coming back in my direction ... 78 yards and closing. It's 4:50 p.m. ... 65 yards ... 53 yards. He's making scrapes every stop. It's 5:00 p.m. He's all fired up! He makes a swooping circle wide of my stand, he makes another scrape, he then doubles back with another circle, this time cutting the distance even further between us. He's now coming within my range. I am going to get an opportunity few can only dream of. It's 5:10 p.m. and he's at 30 yards. My range is set. My bow is tuned. My broadhead is razor sharp. All the scouting, shooting, and preparation is going to come down to one moment, one shot. I draw back, let out a "MEH", he's frozen, I settle my sight pin left and right, and I send it. Impact. He's hit hard. He's darting off in the direction he came. I hear a crash In the distance. It's all over.






