The Criteria for winning these awards are the following:

Double Crown. Any person who, within the same calendar year and competing in the same style & division, wins the championship at the Spring and Fall 3-D Classics, shall be recognized as a VBA Double Crown Champion.

Triple Crown. Any person who, within the same calendar year and competing in the same style & division, wins the championship at the State Indoor, Open and Closed Tournaments shall be recognized as a VBA Triple Crown Champion.


Moving on to the 2019 Indoor Sectional Championship, great work by all the clubs running smooth events. OUTSTANDING JOB!! The VBA would like to thank all the Archers who participated at our 2019 State Indoor Sectional Tournament. 
### Agenda Items Voted on at March Meeting

- (5) VBA By-Laws, Art.1, Board of Directors: Sentence 1, Delete January, Sentence 2, Delete Quarterly. Failed, 24-8
- (4) By-Laws, Section 3.2, Flight Editor: Remove word, Quarterly, and replace with Semi-annually, a publication containing pertinent information. Effective, January 2020. Passed 25-6

### Agenda Items for June meeting

- (1) By-law addition, Art.13, Shooting styles, add Section 13.8, Barebow recurve. Under VBA Rounds, Rules and Styles, add to 6. Shooting Styles, F Barebow Recurve. (1) Follow World Archery rules for Equipment, (2) No class breakdown or divisions in this style for age or sex, except under 18. Effective date, January 2020
- Justification: Fast growing style of shooting and needs to be recognized at state level. Submitted by Two Rivers Archery Club.
- (2) Revise VBA BY-LAWS, page 10, Section 15.1.2, Spring 3-D Classic paragrapgh B to Read.
- B. The Spring 3-D will be a Two- day shoot. Spring 3-D shall be a marked distance for all IBO Classes plus one Known 50 Class for all Males and one Known 40 Class for all Females. There will be a minimum of 25 targets. Maximum distance will 60 yards. Archers have options of shooting 1 or 2 days and counting highest score at the Spring 3-D.
- (3) Revise VBA BY-LAWS, Page 10, Section 15.1.4 Fall 3-D Classic paragraph B to read:
- B. The Fall 3-D will be a two day shoot. Archers must shoot both days. The Fall Classic will be unmarked distances for all IBO classes plus Marked distances for one Known 50 class for all males and one known 40 class for all females. There will be a minimum of 25 targets. Maximum distance will be 50yds.
- Revise VBA Rounds, Rules & Styles, page 34
- L. Combined 3-D Spring / Fall Shooting Rules, paragraphs 2 and 3 to read
2. Targets are to at marked distances for the Spring Classic and at unmarked distances for the IBO Classes plus marked distances for a Known 50 and a Known 40 class for the Fall Classic.
3. Equipment and shooting rules shall follow IBO rules for the IBO classes and for the two Known distance classes.
- To be effective 1 January, 2020
- Justification/Reason for the motion1:
- Add Known distance classes to the VBA Spring and Fall Classic tournaments to allow for awarding the VBA Double Crown awards for the male and female winners of the Known distance classes.

Wally and Winnie’s Wild Turkey Gumbo



Ingredients

- ½ cup peanut oil, lard, or butter
- 1 cup flour
- 1 quart stock, turkey or other good similar stock
- 2 bell peppers, diced
- 2 celery stalks, diced
- 1 large yellow onion, diced
- 6 garlic cloves, minced
- 1 tablespoon tomato paste
- 2 to 4 turkey drumsticks
- ¼ teaspoon celery seed
- 2 bay leaves
- 2 tablespoons Cajun or Creole seasoning
- ¼ to ½ pound smoked sausage or tasso ham, cut into coins or chunks
- 1 pound peeled, raw shrimp
- 1/2 pound sliced okra (or 2 tablespoons filé powder)
- Tabasco or other hot sauce to taste
- Chopped green onions, for garnish



Instructions

- Pour the stock and 1 quart water into a pot and bring it to a simmer.
- In a large, heavy soup pot, heat the peanut oil over medium-high heat. Stir in the flour to make a roux and cook this, stirring often, until it’s the color of milk chocolate. You’ll need to stir this more often as it cooks so it doesn’t burn. This should take about 15 minutes.
- Add the diced vegetables and the garlic, and mix well. Let this cook over medium heat until soft, about 10 minutes. Stir in the tomato paste, celery seed, bay leaves, and Cajun seasoning.
- Bring the stock to a full boil and start adding it ladle by ladle into the soup pot. It will sputter and seize up at first, but keep adding the stock until it has all incorporated. Bring this to a full, rolling boil and let this boil for a couple of minutes.
- Turn the heat back down to a simmer and add the turkey drumsticks. Taste for salt and let this simmer until the meat wants to fall off the bone, a couple of hours. Remove the turkey legs and pull the meat from the bone.
- Add the sausage, shrimp, and okra or about a tablespoon of filé to thicken, and let this simmer 5 minutes. Add Tabasco to taste and serve garnished with green onions over rice.

### **DGIF REPORTS 28 NEW CWD-POSITIVE WHITE-TAILED DEER IN NORTHWEST VIRGINIA**

**RICHMOND-** Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) was confirmed by the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (DGIF) in 26 deer from Frederick County and two deer from Shenandoah County during 2018. Twenty-six of the CWD-positive deer were harvested by hunters and showed no symptoms of the disease. Two infected deer were showing signs of the disease prior to death and were reported to the Department by members of the public.

Over 1,550 deer from Frederick, Clarke, Warren, and Shenandoah counties were tested for CWD during the 2018 hunting season. DGIF appreciates the assistance of deer hunters in this area for their excellent cooperation during CWD sample collections this past fall. Additional appreciation is due to road-kill contractors, deer processors, and taxidermists from these four counties who also assisted with CWD sampling this fall. Since 2009, 66 CWD-positive deer have been confirmed from Frederick (61) and Shenandoah (5) counties. All CWD-positive deer have been harvested located west of Interstate 81.

In addition to the sampling effort in Frederick, Clarke, Warren, and Shenandoah counties, DGIF partnered with dozens of taxidermists to enhance CWD surveillance throughout the remainder of Virginia. This partnership proved effective in securing over 1,500 samples from across the state. The results of this effort are currently pending and will be released when they are received from the laboratory.

CWD has been detected in 26 states and three Canadian provinces. The disease is a slow, progressive neurologic (brain and nervous system) disease found in deer, elk, and moose in North America, which ultimately results in death of the animal. It is spread through urine, feces, and saliva. Symptoms do not appear for several years and include staggering, abnormal posture, lowered head, drooling, confusion, and marked weight loss. There is no evidence that CWD can be naturally transmitted to humans, livestock, or pets, but the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention advise hunters to test all deer harvested from known CWD-positive areas and to not consume any animals that test positive for the disease.



**500 Pin** Any VBA member that scores 500 or better at a VBA sanctioned shoot on a VBA approved range. The round must be shot from the adult stakes on a field, hunter or field/hunter combination round. The scorecard must be signed by 2 witnesses and sent to the Executive State Secretary.

**Perfect Animal** Any VBA member that shoots a 20 or higher on each of the 14 unit animal targets for a total score or 280 or more. The round must be shot from the adult stakes on a VBA approved range at a sanctioned VBA shoot. The scorecard must be signed by 2 witnesses.

Conservation Scholarship





## ORDER OF THE GOLDEN FEATHER

### NOMINATIONS DUE IN MARCH

The VBA Order of the Golden Feather was created to honor those persons who have given unselfishly of their time and talents toward the betterment of archery and archers. Recipients are persons who possess the virtues of sportsmanship, character, morals, integrity and friendship. As a reflection of the substance for membership, only 86 people have been elected to the Order in the past 78 years.

To be qualified, a candidate must be member in good standing of the VBA at the time of nomination, must have a minimum of ten successive years' membership in the VBA and must be sponsored by three VBA members of good standing or by a VBA Club.

This article is a reminder that candidates must be submitted to the Board of Directors at the March meeting for this year. Nominations must be in writing and be signed by sponsoring individuals or a Club officer. Successful nominees have always performed duties or had an impact outside their immediate club.
