

Results Of The March VBA Quarterly Meeting

■ Sherwood Archers moved that the Senior Division have the same class breakdown in each shooting style as the Adult Division. After some discussion concerning additional cost of awards, the unspecified numerical breakdown for each class, etc., President Seltzer ordered that this motion be referred to the Tournament Committee for further study.

■ Field Vice President Mark Lohr moved as follows: "To change the awards at our VBA State Shoots from plaques to medallions. First being the largest with a blue ribbon; second smaller with a red ribbon; third being smallest with a white ribbon. All inscribed. The State Champion plaques would remain the same."

Grilled Italian Steaks With Vegetables

5 medium garlic cloves, crushed
 1½ tsp. dried basil leaves (or to taste)
 ¾ tsp. pepper
 ¼ cup Parmesan cheese, grated
 1 Tbsp. olive oil
 1 Tbsp. red wine vinegar
 1 large red onion, sliced ½" thick

2 to 3 lbs. of venison backstrap or
 round steaks cut 1"+ thick
 2 bell peppers, yellow, red or
 green, or a mixture, quartered
 salt
 pepper
 fresh basil sprigs

Combine garlic, basil and pepper; reserve 2 teaspoons for the steaks. Add cheese, oil and red wine vinegar to the remaining seasonings; brush mixture onto bell peppers and red onion slices. Place onion slices on medium grill. Cook onion for 15 to 20 minutes, turning once. Press the reserved seasonings mixture evenly into both sides of the steaks. Place bell peppers and steaks on grill with the onion. Grill peppers 12 to 15 minutes or until just tender; cook steaks 10 to 14 minutes for medium rare to medium, turning both once. Season steaks with salt and pepper. Serve with vegetables and garnish with fresh basil sprigs. Serves 2.





