VBA Summer League

The summer league will run 18 weeks starting 4/15/24 thru 8/21/24. All cards must be in by 8/24/24 to be counted. Archers must shoot 8 international rounds using an official score card. There will be no breakdown for age, gender or style. This round is 3 arrows shot at 10 targets for a total of 150 points. 20-25-30-35-40-45-50-55-60-65 yards are the distances shot. Field targets or hunter targets may be used, The 15-45 walk-80 and bunny are not shot. The round can be shot at any VBA range in the state and can be shot over more than one day. The score card must have one witness to be counted. Cards can be printed out or you may use your club card. An archer can not start over once starting a round. Cards need to be sent to the tournament director, Jim Little (jlittlejr53@gmail.com) or 703-975-1475), to be counted. They can be emailed back or sent a picture from the phone to the tournament director. Archers may shoot more than one round each week. We will be using a 90% handicap for the shoot. There will be 3 random week scores picked at the end of the shoot and averaged for the handicap. The handicap will be added to the average of the 8 weeks score for a total score. X count will be used to break a tie. A belt Buckle will be given for champion along with a certificate and a certificate for 2nd and 3rd place. There is no cost to shoot. Clubs or Pro Shops may have range fees. If a tie occurs with score and x count we will start with week one and look at x count. Highest x count wins. Then move to next week til we have a winner.

From the Field Vice President

As the new year gets under way, I would like to thank all the archers that shot the Lancaster shoot and the State Indoor. The Indoor was hosted by Sherwood, Bowhunters of Rockingham, Two Rivers and Belvoir Bowhunters. We had 7 records set this year. The Lancaster shoot went well for the first year. We had a few problems and worked them out. \$500 was paid out to archers. We learned a lot and next year should go smoothly. The Indoor League finished up just before the Banquet. Marcus Diehl won the buckle, Darryll Diehl took 2nd, and Jeremy Price took 3rd. The Banquet was held March 23rd in Harrisonburg. Seventy two attended for a great time, good food and great door prizes. We gave out 10 Triple Crown, 7 Double Crown awards. Awards for Big Buck, Big Bear Turkey Big Doe, and 2 Triple Slam, 4 Double Slam. There were 2 second tier and 1 first tier Dave Proctor award along with several Bill Bennett awards. The outdoor season is starting up. Get out and support your clubs. April 27 & 28 is the Spring 3d at Sherwood. This is an unmarked round. On September 7 & 8 Massanutten is hosting the Closed. This will be 28 field, 14 Hunter-14 Animals.

ARTICLE 15, Section 15.1.10 registration fees pg 11 change to read

- A. Registration fees for the State Open, Indoor, Spring 3d, Fall 3d for VBA members shall be \$30 for each for first two adult archers and \$10 for each youth family member with a max of \$60. Fees for non-VBA members shall be \$40 per person with no breakdown. Distribution of registration fees shall be 70% to the host club and 30% to VBA.

Pg 15 Section 16.1.2 Rules Change to read

Candidates will be elected by a 90% majority vote of the Order. Ballots shall be mailed out to active members 45 days prior to the September meeting. Unopened ballots shall be counted at the September meeting.

Effective 7/1/2024





Wally and Winnie like this Savory Venison Meatloaf



Ingredients

- 1 pound ground venison
- ½ yellow onion, chopped
- 1 cup barbecue sauce, divided
- 1 large egg
- 1 (4 ounce) packet saltine crackers, finely crushed
- 4 tablespoons brown sugar, divided
- 3 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce, divided
- ½ teaspoon dried sage
- ½ teaspoon steak seasoning
- 3 slices bacon

Directions

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
Mix together venison, onion, 1/4 cup barbecue sauce, egg, crushed crackers, 2 tablespoons brown sugar, 2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce, sage, and steak seasoning in a large bowl with your hands until evenly combined. Pack into a 3x7-inch loaf pan. Lay bacon slices over the top.

Bake in the preheated oven until no longer pink in the center and bacon is crispy, about 35 minutes. An instant-read thermometer inserted into the center should read at least 160 degrees F (70 degrees C).

Meanwhile, stir together remaining 3/4 cup barbecue sauce, 2 tablespoons brown sugar, and 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce in a small saucepan over medium heat. Simmer for 5 minutes, whisking constantly, until sauce is heated through and slightly thickened.

Pour sauce over cooked meatloaf and let rest for 5 minutes before serving.



VBA Scholarship Program





ORDER OF THE GOLDEN FEATHER

NOMINATIONS DUE IN MARCH

The VBA Order of the Golden Feather was created to honor those persons who have given unselfishly of their time and talents toward the betterment of archery and archers. Recipients are persons who possess the virtues of sportsmanship, character, morals, integrity and friendship. As a reflection of the substance for membership, only 86 people have been elected to the Order in the past 78 years.

To be qualified, a candidate must be member in good standing of the VBA at the time of nomination, must have a minimum of ten successive years' membership in the VBA and must be sponsored by three VBA members of good standing or by a VBA Club.

This article is a reminder that candidates must be submitted to the Board of Directors at the March meeting for this year. Nominations must be in writing and be signed by sponsoring individuals or a Club officer. Successful nominees have always performed duties or had an impact outside their immediate club.
