VBA Meeting highlights

Due to the mass confusion and disapproval of the Handicap system as used in "Flight Competition" it was decided that VBA would drop this method of grouping.

Beginning immediately all clubs should use the "Class Competition" system as outlined in the NF AA Blue Book on Handicaps pages 8 & 9. If you do not have this book, write to Nancy Western for a copy. It was also decided to give clubs permission to vary the point breakdown slightly to suit the local needs. All class grouping must be by handicap and all shooting within the class by raw score.


Since going to this system it was decided that the Animal Round will remain as one of the State Shoot rounds. Repeating, the Animal Round will be shot at the State Shoot.



The ranges of the Richmond Archers were the site of the 1969 Mid-Atlantic Regional Field Archery Tournament held on June 21 and 22. The two-day shoot, consisting of a hunter and field round on Saturday and an animal round on Sunday, was a complete success. The nice spring-like weather made the shooting enjoyable for the approximately 250 archers from seven states and D.C. Judging from the many comments made during the shoot, Richmond has once again demonstrated Southern hospitality for which it has become famous up and down the East Coast.

While the cool temperatures allowed for comfortable shooting, the competition was quite hot as evidenced by the winning scores below:
