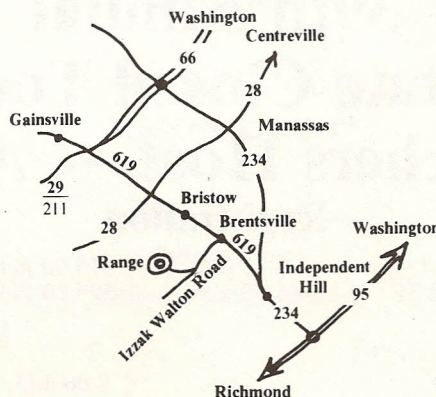

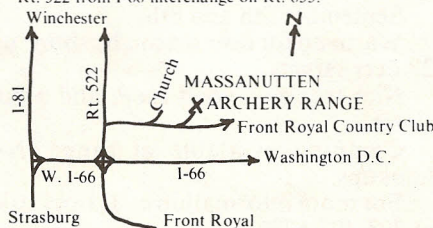
—16 June — Pin shoot with casual registration from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

misunderstandings about tournament
reports and 20-Pins and cut down on
correspondence.Tournament reports should be mailed
Tuesday following the shoot. Reports
should be sent in for any tournament
(club included) that has an official round.
(28—Field, 28—Hunter or 14 of each)
Be sure to use the names as they appear
on the handicap card (no nicknames)
and list their VBA ID number. This is
necessary because the scores are trans-
ferred to the members record card and
makes it possible to find the correct
card. Scores should be sent in on time to
enable scores to appear in date order.
The style (BB, FS, FS-L, BH, FSBH,
FSBH-L) should also be listed.20-Pins should be sent in by the
Secretary or Tournament Chairman of
the club where the twenty was shot.
When the 20-Pin application is signed,
this indicates that it has been checked
out to make sure the score card (which
has been signed by two witnesses and
recorded properly—number one score
on number one target, etc.), application
and range approval all correspond. The
card should be marked Field, Hunter or
if 14 of each was shot, mark each 14.
Field and Hunter Pins should not be
applied for on the same application,
since these are kept on file and in separ-
ate drawers. If for some reason the
archer has to send the application in
later, check out the application for accu-
racy before returning it to him/her. If
these instructions are followed, it will
virtually eliminate the many mistakes
and necessity to return applications.**Flight Deadline**The deadline for the July-Aug. issue
of FLIGHT will be Aug. 1, 1985.

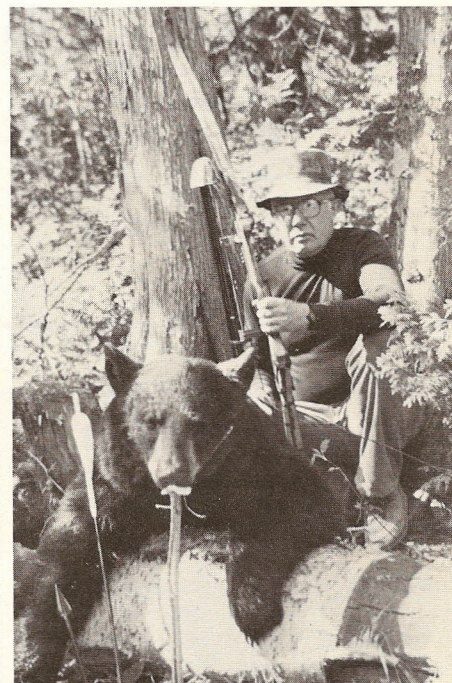
