A believed-to-be record crowd of 126 archers attended. Competition as usual was tight as the scores, which are listed elsewhere in Flight, reflect.

Even as the last arrows in regular competition were shot, those that stayed for the award ceremony were treated to a shoot-off in three different divisions; 1st place in Men Men's Freestyle A, 1st place in Women's Barebow, and 2nd place in Men's Barebow B.

1976 VBA Bowhunting Report

To date, 58 Bill Bennett applications have been received for deer taken during the 1976 season. Some interesting statistics emerged from analyzing the data included on the applications. For example of the total of 58 deer taken, 37 were killed in the afternoon or evening. One would think more deer would be taken in the morning since it is generally agreed that deer are less alert in the morning when returning to their bedding areas. Maybe the answer is simply that more people hunt in the afternoon and evenings (possibly after work).

Some definite trends in equipment used were evident from analyzing the applications. One trend is that more and more bowhunters are using broadheads with replaceable blades. I personally view this as beneficial. Some bowhunters don't have the skill or inclination to put a shaving sharp edge on a conventional broadhead. The tragic result is wounded game that could have been quickly and humanely dispatched had a razor sharp broadhead been used: Bear 15, Wasp 11, Super S 11, Black Diamond 7, Razorback 3, Missle Spike 3, Satellite 2, Chisle point 2, Copperhead 1, Lil Shaver 1, Herters 1, Unknown 1.

The average bow weight used was 55 lbs. with the lightest being 35 lbs and the heaviest 74 lbs.

The longest shot was 65 yards; the shortest 5 yards; the average 22 yards.







The longest distance any deer traveled after being hit was 400 yards. Several were dropped immediately. The average distance traveled was 74 yards.

There were 32 bucks harvested and 26 does.
