STATE OF THE VBA 2023



JANUARY 1, 2023

As my second term as VBA President draws to a close. I would like to take this opportunity to go over the accomplishments and challenges facing the VBA.

1. Accomplishments!

We successfully made it through covid and took the organization from running in the red to running in the black. We had to make difficult decisions regarding flight, Officer reimbursements, in-person meetings etc. it has worked we finished the year as a strong organization! We are the second largest hunting group in the state behind the Bear hunters. We successfully lobbied the house of delegates and State senate on not putting the Air bow/Gun in Archery season! As well as getting Sunday hunting passed on public and private land. We have Opened a dialogue With the DWR with our concerns and opposition to the Three Day Bear season the week before Archery Season and the Proposed Expanded Chase/ Training Season in September. We are once again very vocal and advocating for the Bowhunters in the state of VA.

We have a seat on the DWR Black Bear council.

2. Challenges facing the VBA!

The challenges we currently have facing us are the club's unwillingness to work together to better the sport of tournament archery in the state. We have had clubs holding shoots over state shoots and not have any regrets in doing so! The Clubs no longer care about the other local clubs and helping everyone succeeded! This association was formed with the principle to help every archery club and Bowhunter to be successful and to make sure we weren't disenfranchised in Richmond. Youth involvement we are not getting youth involved in to bow hunting and target shooting. New Officers, We have had no one express interest in any office! If we do not find a slate of officers, the Association will either fold or run under a new format instead of Roberts rules of order. Maybe it's time we go to a Strictly Bowhunting org. Like the IBO etc.

3. New Ideas / Solutions

First, getting the kids and new archers into the sport. I am currently working on a youth and apprentice hunt to be sponsored by the VBA.

Second, I would like to see the VBA establish a fund for any VBA member that wants to become a certified archery instructor. The VBA will foot the bill in return the new Coach/Instructor will hold a youth Day locally to their location at least once a year for three years. We have the equipment to loan for such things. We also have some new sponsors Reedy's Archery Shop in Amherst has given us a second scholarship for \$500! But we need people that are going to college to apply for it. We also need to get new blood to serve on the board and committees. We have had no takers for the Hunting and Tournament Committees! Also we need to get the kids involved!

Votes will capped at 3 votes, Roll call vote was taken, passed 16-2

3- Agenda Item to change the scheduling session made by the tournament committee. An Excell spread sheet will be sent to each club with the state shoots and meeting dates on it. Clubs can enter their shoots on it. The sheet will be updated as needed to keep all zones in line. At the September meeting the final sheet will be voted on for approval. Item Passed 16-1

Motion to change maximum shooting distance at State Shoots in the BBR class

Pg 37 section H Barebow Recurve (BBR) section

Add line 2 to read

BBR style for women and Master senior male classes will shoot 30 yards maximum in all field, Hunter and animal rounds. On targets less than 30 yards archers will shoot adult stakes. On targets over 30 yards archers will shoot the cub stakes. Adult men senior and sliver senior will shoot a maximum of 50 yards. In all field, hunter and animal rounds. All targets under 50 yards the adult stakes will be used. On targets over 50 yards the youth stakes will be used.

Justification

The BBR class was started as a trial with no breakdown for age or sex. The next year it was changed to add male and female plus adult and senior divisions. The past two years several archers have questioned shooting out to 80 yards especially seniors. They are limited on the pondage they can pull. There is not much difference between there equipment than Traditional. The biggest difference is they walk the string. By changing the distances more shooters might be willing to try state shoots.

2023 VBA INDOOR LEAGUE

The indoor league will run 12/19/2022 thru 3/13/2023 for a total of 13 weeks. During that time you will shoot a round each week for a total 12- 300 rounds on the blue single spot or 5 spot targets. A missed week can be shot at the end or the archer can shoot 2 rounds in a week. Archers wishing to shoot must email the TVP to get a set of rules and a copy of the scorecard. Cards must be turned in by Tuesday the following week by email or a picture on the phone to be a official rounds Cards must be signed by shooter and witness. Rounds may be shot on any 20 yard range at any time during the week .Count X's as they will be used for tie breakers . Count inside-out x's also. The official card will have space for all info needed. Please fill completely so your score can be counted. The scores will be posted each week by Thursday. The Belt Buckle will be given out at the Banquet on March 25th 2023 for high score and a certificate for 2nd and 3rd. A 90% handicap will be used. To find the handicap 3 random scores will be drawn then averaged . Then the handicap will be added to each weeks score. All 12 weeks score and x count will averaged for final score Total Inside out x's for tie breaker. There is no cost to shoot. Clubs or pro shops may have a range fee. You must be a VBA member. I will confirm all memberships the week of March 19. Please feel free to contact me with questions or concerns . Rounds shot at other league can be used for this shoot. 2023 VBA SUMMER LEAGUE

The summer league will run 12 weeks starting 4/17/23 thru 7/10/23 with makeup week 7/24/23 thru 7/30/23. Archers must shoot one international round half per week using official score card. There will be no breakdown for age, gender or style. This round is 3 arrows shot at 10 targets for a total of 150 points. 20-25-30-35-40-45-50-55-60-65 yards are the distances shot Field targets or hunter targets may be used.. The 15- 45 walk up- 80 and bunny are not shot. The round can be shot at any VBA range in the state and can be shot over more than one day. The score card must have one witness to be counted . Cards can be printed out printed out each week. The shoot starts on Monday of each week and ends on Sunday. A archer can not start over once starting a round. Cards need to be sent in by Tuesday to the tournament director Jim Little (jlittlejr53@gmail.com 703-975-1475) be counted. They can be emailed back or send a picture from the phone to the tournament director Results will be posted by Thursday that week. We will be using a 90% handicap for the shoot. There will be 3 random week scores picked at the end of the shoot and your average will come from that. The handicap will be added to each of the 12 weeks score for a total score.. X count will be used to break a tie. A belt Buckle will be given for champion along with a certificate and a certificate for 2nd and 3rd place. . There is no cost to shoot. Clubs or Pro Shops may have range fees.

NOMINATIONS DUE IN MARCH

The VBA Order of the Golden Feather was created to honor those persons who have given unselfishly of their time and talents toward the betterment of archery and archers. Recipients are persons who possess the virtues of sportsmanship, character, morals, integrity and friendship. As a reflection of the substance for membership, only 86 people have been elected to the Order in the past 78 years.

To be qualified, a candidate must be member in good standing of the VBA at the time of nomination, must have a minimum of ten successive years' membership in the VBA and must be sponsored by three VBA members of good standing or by a VBA Club.

This article is a reminder that candidates must be submitted to the Board of Directors at the March meeting for this year. Nominations must be in writing and be signed by sponsoring individuals or a Club officer. Successful nominees have always performed duties or had an impact outside their immediate club.
